WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost seven of the last 10 games and 14 of the last 20 as they open the final series of the 2018 season with a split doubleheader at Minnesota.
- RHPs Reynaldo López and Lucas Giolito, who are making their final starts of the season, will take the mound for the Sox.
- The Sox are currently in third place in the American League Central, 1.5 games behind third-place Detroit (64-95).
- The White Sox went 2-4 on their final homestand of the season, losing two of three to both the Cubs and Cleveland ... they finished with a 30-51 record at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- The White Sox went 4-5 on their last trip at the Indians (1-2), Baltimore (2-1) and Kansas City (1-2).

TODAY'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox need to win one of their final four games to avoid the fourth 100-loss season in franchise history.
- The Sox are 15-8 (.652) on the road since 8/3, the fourth-best mark in MLB ... pitchers own a 3.57 ERA (82 ER/206.2 IP) and .233 opponents average with 16 quality starts during that span.
- Chicago has won six of the last nine games vs. Minnesota after losing five of the first six to start the season series.
- The Sox are hitting .221/.281/.345 with 20 homers and 64 runs scored (3.2 R/G) in the last 20 games ... have left 138 runners on base and own a .237 RISP mark (32-135) during that span.
- Reynaldo López is 3-0 with a 0.79 (3 ER/34.0 IP), 20 hits allowed, 36 strikeouts, a .165 opponents average and 0.76 WHIP over his last five starts (see note below).
- Lucas Giolito has worked at least 6.0 IP in each of his last eight road starts, going 4-2 with a 3.44 ERA (20 ER/52.1 IP), .212 opponents average and seven quality starts.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Cleveland scored 10 unanswered runs from the first inning through the sixth in its 10-2, series-clinching win.
- Francisco Lindor hit a leadoff home run to open the scoring, and the Indians added one run in the third, three in the fourth, two in the fifth and three in the sixth.
- Jace Fry (1 ER/1.0 IP) suffered the loss after making his first career start as part of a "bullpen day" for the White Sox.
- Kevan Smith and Adam Engel drove in the Sox only runs with RBI singles in the ninth.
- Chicago struck out 13 times, recorded five singles (six hits total), went 2-8 with RISP and left eight runners on base.

LET'S PLAY TWO

- The White Sox are playing their fourth doubleheader of the season and second at home ... the Sox split twinbills on 4/28 at Kansas City, 6/5 at Minnesota and 6/22 vs. Oakland.

6.0 (IP), 1 (R) AND DONE

- Reynaldo López has made five straight starts allowing one run or less and five hits or less in 6.0-plus IP ... he is just the third Sox pitcher to record a five-game streak with those numbers, joining Joe Horlen (5/11-29/68) and Billy Pierce (5/21-6/8/57).
- López and Pittsburgh's Trevor Williams (8/11-9/3) are the only pitchers in MLB this season to record such a streak ... the last pitcher to record a streak of six starts was Ervin Santana in 2017.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- Lucas Giolito is 7-5 with a 4.35 ERA (48 ER/99.1 IP) and .231 opponents average over his 16 road starts ... he has allowed three earned runs or less in 13 of the outings.
- By comparison, he owns a 7.80 ERA (63 ER/72.2 IP) at home ... he has allowed five or more runs eight times.

- The ticket donation is a thank you from Renteria to the staff who were involved in his care while he was a patient last month ... he also sent a shipment of Nuts on Clark "Chicago mix" popcorn.
- He missed four games from 8/20-23 due to lightheadedness.

WHITE SOX VS. MINNESOTA

- The Twins lead the season series, 8-7 ... the Sox are 3-3 at Target Field and went 4-5 at Guaranteed Rate Field.
- Game 1 today is the final makeup from three snow postponements at Target Field from 4/13-15.
- The White Sox are batting .247/.304/.403 with 17 home runs, and own a 3.64 ERA (55 ER/136.0 IP) with eight quality starts ... both teams have scored 64 runs this season.
- The Sox are 8-11 in the last 19 games at Target Field.
- Chicago is 3-12-2 in the last 17 season matchups (2001-17).
- The White Sox trail in the all-time series, 432-481 ... they are 234-223 at home (120-104 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 198-258 on the road (39-43 at Target Field).

LACK OF CENTRAL COMMAND

- Chicago is 30-42 against the American League Central in 2018, going 14-23 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 15-20 on the road.
- The White Sox will record a losing record vs. the AL Central for the sixth consecutive season.
- The Sox have lost eight of the last 11 overall but won 13 of 24.
- Chicago is 8-5 over the last 13 road games vs. the division.
- The White Sox are 320-420 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-36).

(DIS)COMFORT OF HOME

- The White Sox lost nine of their last 11 games at Guaranteed Rate Field and finished 30-51 (.370) at home this season, the second-worst mark in MLB ahead of Baltimore (27-50, .351).
- This season marks the Sox fourth-worst home record in club history, ahead of 1948 (27-48), 1932 (28-49) and 1970 (31-53).
- Chicago will finish with a sub-.500 record at home for the fifth time in the last six seasons (45-36 in 2016).

HOMER HAPPY

- The Sox have hit 96 homers since 7/2, tied for the fourth-highest total in the American League and tied for seventh in MLB.
- The White Sox feature six players with 17-plus home runs this season, tied for the third-most in MLB (Dodgers, 8; Yankees, 7).
- Chicago has hit 98 HRs on the road, compared to 82 at home.

POWER AND SPEED

- Tim Anderson (20 HR/26 SB) is the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season ... he is four steals shy of joining Alex Rios (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only Sox to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.
- Anderson, Boston's Mookie Betts, Cleveland's José Ramírez and Colorado's Trevor Story are the only players in MLB with at least 20 home runs and 25 stolen bases this season.

PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka is tied with Zeke Bonura (1934) for third place in White Sox single-season history among rookies with 27 home runs in 2018 ... he is eight shy of Ron Kittle (35 in 1983) for second ... the 27 homers are the most by a Sox left-handed rookie.
- He ranks among MLB rookie leaders in homers (T1st, 27), RBI (T3rd, 66), total bases (7th, 197) and extra-base hits (T7th, 44).
- Palka is trying to become the first White Sox rookie to lead all MLB rookies in home runs since José Abreu (36) in 2014.
- His four pinch-hit HRs are the most in a season in Sox history.

YOUNG AND PRODUCTIVE

- Yoán Moncada needs two doubles to become the fifth player in White Sox history, age 23 or younger, to record 30-plus doubles, 15-plus home runs and 60-plus RBI in a single season.
- He would join Chet Lemon (1977), Frank Thomas (1991), Paul Konerko (1999) and Carlos Lee (1999) ... also would be the first Sox, 23 or younger, with a 30+ 2B/15+ HR/60+ RBI/10+ SB season.

GRAB SOME BENCH

- Chicago has struck out 1,551 times in 2018, the most in MLB this season, the most in a single season in franchise history and the second-most in a season in MLB history.
- Milwaukee owns the single-season mark with 1,571 in 2017.
- Yoán Moncada leads MLB with 214 strikeouts, five more than the Yankees' Giancarlo Stanton (209) ... he is eight shy of tying Adam Dunn (222 in 2012) for the club record.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- Chicago has made 1,388 QS since 2003, the second-most in MLB behind the Mets (1,390) during that span, and 57 more than Oakland (1,331), the next-closest American League team.
- The Sox rank third in the AL with 73 quality starts in 2018 ... RHP James Shields is tied for sixth in the AL with 19 QS, and RHP Reynaldo López is tied for 10th with 18.

LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 32nd start of the season, 17th on the road and fourth against the Minnesota Twins.
- Is 3-0 with a 0.79 ERA (3 ER/34.0 IP), 36 strikeouts and a .165 (20-121) opponents average over his last five starts.
- Is 2-2 with a 3.93 ERA (15 ER/34.1 IP), 24 strikeouts and a .246 (31-126) opponents average over his last six road starts ... has tossed 6.0 IP in only two of those starts.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

EAST START

- Received his seventh win of the season and second consecutive on 9/21 vs. Chicago Cubs ... allowed one run on five hits with eight strikeouts over 7.0 IP ... is the first White Sox starter to allow one run or less in 6.0-plus IP in five straight starts since Eric King from 4/22-5/8/89 (also five).
- Received a season-high 10 runs of support (last on 9/16/17 at Detroit).
- Departed with the White Sox leading, 10-1, after throwing 108 pitches (70 strikes) ... the White Sox went on to win, 10-4 ... Kevan Smith and Daniel Palka each homered in the win.

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD

- Is limiting opponents to a .209 average with RISP (32-153) and .169 mark with RISP/two outs (12-71) this season ... opponents are 53-247 (.215) with RISP and 21-111 (.189) with RISP/two outs in his career.
- His .209 opponents average with RISP is the fourth-lowest in the American League.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- Is making his 24th career start on the road ... has gone 8-9 with a 4.68 ERA (68 ER/130.2 IP), 106 strikeouts and a .265 (133-501) opponents average in his career.
- Owns a 4-6 record with a 4.28 ERA (42 ER/88.1 IP), 69 strikeouts and a .260 (87-334) opponents average in 16 road starts this season ... has allowed only six home runs on the road this season, and just two in his last eight road starts.

HELP WANTED

- Owns a 3.45 run support average (70 RS/182.2 IP) in 2018, the second lowest in the majors.
- Has received three runs of support or less in 22 of his 31 starts ... the Sox have scored a season-high 10 runs of support in his last start.
- Received a 7.55 RSA (40 RS/47.2 IP) in eight starts last season.

NO DECISION MADE

- Is tied for third in the MLB with 15 no decisions this season ... owns a 3.07 ERA (31 ER/91.0 IP) in those starts.
- The Sox have scored a total of 20 runs of support in his 15 no decisions this season ... including one run three times, two runs three times and three runs once ... the Sox are 6-8 when López receives a no decision.

DAY AND NIGHT

- Is 4-5 with a 3.48 ERA (37 ER/95.2 IP), .212 (75-354) opponents average and .645 opponents OPS in 16 day starts (10 quality) this season ... compared to 3-4 with a 4.45 ERA (43 ER/87.0 IP), .260 (86-331) opponents average and .791 opponents OPS in 15 night starts (eight quality).
- Has gone 5-5 with a 3.91 ERA (46 ER/106.0 IP), .220 (87-396) opponents average and .670 opponents OPS in 20 career appearances (17 starts, 10 quality) during the day, compared to 10-10 with a 4.44 ERA (83 ER/168.1 IP), .261 (170-652) opponents average and .767 opponents OPS in 30 career games (28 starts) at night.

MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he threw 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE CENTRAL

- Is making his 21st career start against the American League Central ... is 4-5 with a 4.39 ERA (58 ER/119.0 IP), 70 strikeouts and a .264 (122-462) opponents average in 20 career starts.
- Fifteen of his 31 starts this season have come against the American League Central ... is 1-4 with a 4.72 ERA (46 ER/87.2 IP), 60 strikeouts and a .263 (88-334) opponents average ... owns a 3.08 (30 RS/87.2 IP) run support average during those starts ... has received three runs once, two runs twice and zero runs six times ... seven of his 15 outings vs. the division have been quality.
- Received a no decision in his last start on 9/3 vs. Detroit ... allowed one run on four hits over 7.0 IP ... has tossed at least 6.0 IP in 10 of his 15 starts against the division this season.

VS. MINNESOTA TWINS

- Is scheduled to make his fourth career start against the Twins.
- Is 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (8 ER/20.0 IP), eight strikeouts and a .188 (13-69) opponents average lifetime.
- Earned the win in his last start on 6/26 vs. Minnesota ... allowing four runs on six hits with four strikeouts over 6.1 IP.

GAME 2 SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP Lucas Giolito (10-12, 5.81 ERA) is scheduled to game two of the doubleheader, 17th on the road and fifth against the Minnesota Twins
- Is 0-3 with a 5.60 ERA (17 ER/27.1 IP), 20 strikeouts and a .252 (27-107) opponents average over his last five starts.
- Is 2-2 with a 3.82 ERA (13 ER/30.2 IP), 17 strikeouts and a .230 (26-113) opponents average over five career starts against the Twins.
