**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Phillies finish the regular season today with the 19th meeting between the teams this season...The Braves opened the year with a three-game set against the Phillies, closed the season with this three-game series, and will open next year with a three games at Citizens Bank Park as well.

*A* The Braves lead the season set, 12-6, after the clubs split the first two games of this series.

*A* With Friday night's victory, the Braves tied the Atlanta-era, single-season record for most wins over Philadelphia...The 2012 team also won 12 games...They have now won at least 11 games over Philadelphia in six of the last seven years; they went 6-13 against the Phillies last season.

*A* RHP Kevin Gausman is set to face Philadelphia for the third time this season and for the second time in a Braves uniform...The righty allowed three runs, earned, and five hits, but was left with a no-decision in an 8-3 win on September 20...That game was the opener of a four-game series sweep over Philadelphia that helped the Braves clinch the National League East.

*A* LHP Ranger Suárez is set to make his fourth career appearance and third start today...The lefty has never faced the Braves and is 1-1 with a 8.00 ERA (8 ER/9.0 IP) in his two starts.

**SCENARIOS:** The Braves can secure home-field advantage for the National League Division Series with a win and a loss by both Colorado and Los Angeles... Colorado is playing host to Washington, while the Dodgers are in San Francisco.

*A* Any other scenario will result in the Braves travelling for Game 1 of the NLDS, which is on Thursday, October 4.

*A* Game 2 is on Friday, October 5, with Game 3 on Sunday, October 7...If necessary, Game 4 is scheduled for Monday, October 8.

**90 WINS:** With Friday night's victory, the Braves earned their 90th win of the season...They became the first National League team to reach 90 wins in a season following three or more consecutive 90-loss seasons since the 1991 Braves.

*A* That 1991 club went 94-68 and reached the World Series after four consecutive 90-loss seasons.

*A* The Braves went 67-95 in 2015, 68-93 in 2016 and 72-90 last season.

*A* The Braves earned the franchise's 18th 90-win season since Major League Baseball went to a 162-game schedule in 1962 for the NL.

*A* The 18 total 90-win seasons since 1962 are tied for the second most in the National League with St. Louis and San Francisco...The Dodgers, 90-71 this year, lead with 24 such seasons.

**HOME RUNS:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. has a team-high 26 home runs, two more than 2B Ozzie Albies... Acuña Jr. is looking to become the first rookie to lead Braves outright in home runs since 1943, when Chuck Workman hit 10 for the Boston Braves.

*A* Workman, a 28-year-old rookie, was the only player who hit double-digit homers for the Braves that season, as the club finished with 39 total home runs.

**HITS:** 1B Freddie Freeman is tied for the major league lead with a career-high 191 hits...Kansas City's Whit Merrifield also has 191.

*A* Freeman is trying to become the first Braves player to lead the majors in total hits since 1968, when Felipe Alou had 210 to tie Cincinnati's Pete Rose for the most.

*A* The last Braves player to lead the majors outright in hits was Alou, who had 218 in 1966.

*A* The last Braves player to lead the National League in hits was Terry Pendleton, who had 199 in 1992 to tie Pittsburgh's Andy Van Slyke for the most in the league...The last Braves player to lead outright was Pendleton (187) in 1991.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Braves collected their 47th win of the season away from SunTrust Park Friday night, and have the best road record in the National League at 47-33 (.588).

*A* The 47 road wins are the club's most in a single season since the 2004 team also won 47.

*A* The 2002 team was the last to win more than 47 road games, going 49-31 (.613).

**162:** OF Nick Markakis has started every game this season and is trying to become the fifth Braves player since the National League went to a 162-game schedule in 1962 to start all 162.

*A* OF Felix Milán did in 1969, before OF Andruw Jones started 162 in 1999...OF Jeff Francoeur started every game in consecutive seasons, 2006 and 2007, before 1B Freddie Freeman accomplished the feat in 2014.

**DOUBLES:** 2B Ozzie Albies collected his 40th double of the season Friday night, joining OF Nick Markakis and 1B Freddie Freeman as the third Braves player to reach 40 doubles this season.

*A* This is the first time in franchise history the Braves have had three players reach that mark in a single season...The team only had two players reach 40 doubles in season once before...Jeff Francoeur (40) and Chipper Jones (42) accomplished the feat in 2007.

*A* The last time a National League team accomplished the feat was 2006, when Garret Atkins, Todd Helton and Matt Holliday all reached 40 doubles for the Colorado Rockies.

#### Today's Game

- A* Makes his 31st start of the season, and the 137th of his career (160th appearance).
  - A* Made at least 30 starts for the third consecutive season, including a majors-most 34 starts last year.
- A* Defeated Washington, September 14, to improve to 5-2 since joining Atlanta.
  - A* His five wins with the Braves are the most for an Atlanta pitcher acquired in-season since 2000, when Andy Ashby went 8-6 over 15 turns with Atlanta after being acquired from Philadelphia... Research courtesy STATS, LLC.
  - A* Milt Pappas went 10-8 after the Braves acquired him in 1968 to set the Atlanta-era record... Pappas, Ashby and Doyle Alexander (6-6 in 1986) are the only Atlanta pitchers with more wins than Gausman after being acquired in-season.
- A* In nine starts with Atlanta since the Braves acquired him on July 31, is 5-2 with a 2.80 ERA (17 ER/54.2 IP) and a .224 opponents' batting average.
  - A* Since Atlanta inserted Gausman into its rotation, Braves starters are 19-15 with a 3.13 ERA... The ERA is third lowest in the majors.
  - A* The Braves have gone 7-2 in his eight turns.
- A* Makes just his third career start against Philadelphia, all of which have come this season... Is 0-1 with a 6.35 ERA (8 ER/11.1 IP) in his previous two starts.
  - A* Pitched against them in his last start, September 20 at SunTrust Park... Allowed five hits and three runs over 6.1 innings in Atlanta's 8-3 win.

#### 2018 Recap

- A* Is undefeated in his first five career starts at SunTrust Park, going 3-0 with a 2.81 ERA (10 ER/32.0 IP)... Atlanta has won each of his five starts.
  - A* The Braves are 5-0 when Gausman pitches at SunTrust Park, the longest career-opening stretch of team wins in a pitcher's starts at home for Atlanta since 2008, when the Braves won each of Jair Jurrjens' first eight starts at Turner Field.
- A* Atlanta won five consecutive games started by Gausman, 8/10-9/1, tied for the longest run of team wins in a pitcher's starts for the Braves this season.
  - A* Atlanta won five straight starts by Aníbal Sánchez from 4/13-6/14, and five straight by Sean Newcomb from 4/26-5/19.
  - A* The Braves have not won more than five consecutive starts by one pitcher since 2013, when Atlanta ran off eight consecutive wins in starts by Mike Minor, and six straight wins in games started by Julio Teheran.
- A* Went 6.0 innings and allowed three runs (one earned), 9/1 vs. PIT.
  - A* Allowed a pair of unearned runs in the fifth inning, snapping a 19.0-inning scoreless streak... It was the longest scoreless run in the N.L. at the time.
- A* Made his SunTrust Park debut, 8/10 vs. MIL, and allowed six hits and just one run over 8.0 innings... Fanned eight without walking a batter.
  - A* Became the first Braves pitcher to toss 8.0 innings in his home debut since Matt Wisler held New York-NL to one run over 8.0 frames on 6/19/15 at Turner Field.
  - A* Gausman fell three outs shy of his first 9.0-inning complete game... The last Braves pitcher to throw a complete game in his home debut was Andy Ashby, who tossed a four-hitter to beat New York-NL, 1-0 on 7/23/90.
- A* The Braves acquired Gausman in a six-player trade with the Baltimore Orioles on 7/31.
  - A* Atlanta acquired Gausman and RHP Darren O'Day from Baltimore in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Evan Phillips, INF Jean Carlos Encarnación, C Brett Cumberland, LHP Bruce Zimmerman and international signing slots.
  - A* Went 5-8 with a 4.43 ERA (61 ER/124.0 IP) in 21 starts for the Orioles, leading the staff in starts and innings pitched.
  - A* Went 3-4 with a 6.39 ERA (35 ER/49.1 IP) in nine starts against the A.L. East... In his remaining 12 starts, was 2-4 with a 3.13 ERA (26 ER/74.2 IP)
- A* Made his Braves debut, 8/4 at NYM... Allowed six hits and three runs over 5.0 innings in Atlanta's 3-0 defeat.
  - A* Is the first starter to pitch for Atlanta after being acquired in a July trade since Paul Maholm in 2012... Maholm went 4-5 with a 3.54 ERA over 11 starts for Atlanta after the Braves acquired him and OF Reed Johnson in exchange for RHP Aroldys Vizcaíno and RHP Jaye Chapman on 7/30/12.
  - A* Reliever James Russell was acquired by Atlanta in July of 2014 and made 21 appearances out of the bullpen before ending the season with a spot start.
- A* Earned his fifth win of the season in his final start with the Orioles, 7/28 vs. TB... Allowed nine hits and two runs over 7.0 innings in Baltimore's 11-2 win.
  - A* The outing was his team-most 11th quality start, and the fifth time he worked at least 7.0 innings

#### Career Recap

- A* Went 39-51 with a 4.22 ERA (358 ER/763.2 IP) over 150 games, 127 starts, with the Orioles... Spent his entire six-year major league career with Baltimore before Atlanta acquired him.
- A* Selected fourth overall by the Orioles out of Louisiana State University in the first round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft.

- Recalled, 8/29, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint on the active roster...Was also up from 8/11-18, and on 8/7 and 7/31...Was added to the roster as the 26th man for the doubleheader on 8/7...Had his contract selected, 7/31, and started versus Miami in his major league debut...Optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame that night.
- Has allowed seven earned runs over 3.0 innings in two relief appearances with the Braves...Last pitched for Atlanta on 8/17 vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R).
- Started vs. MIA, 7/31, in his major league debut...Allowed nine hits and five runs (four earned) over 5.0 innings to earn the win...At the age of 20 years, 352 days, became the youngest left-hander to win his debut for the Braves since Charlie Vaughan did so on September 3, 1966 at the age of 18 years, 332 days.
- Is 6-4 with a 2.72 ERA (34 ER/112.1 IP) in 19 starts for Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

- Allowed a season-most three earned runs, 9/17 vs. STL, after walking two and allowing a three-run homer... Twelve of the 22 earned runs he has allowed this season have come via home run, including four of his last seven.
- Has allowed six earned runs in his last 4.0 innings (six appearances)...Opponents are hitting .267 and he has issued five walks in that span.
- Has a 3.11 ERA in 59 relief appearances for Atlanta this season, the sixth-lowest ERA by a left-handed rookie reliever in franchise history...Jonny Venters' 1.95 ERA in 2010 is lowest.
- Pitched more than 1.0 inning in 14 outings this season, compiling a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts... Three of his five wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
