TODAY'S GAME: In their final meeting at Coors Field, the Giants and Rockies face off for game one of this three game series...San Francisco is coming off a nine-game homestand against Texas (2-1), Arizona (2-1) and New York-NL (1-2)...SF will try to snap their five game losing skid on Labor Day.

GIANTS ROSTER MOVE: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to today's game: **RHP Casey Kelly** (#68), **RHP Pierce Johnson** (#58) and **LHP Steven Okert** (#32) have been recalled from triple-A Sacramento...the Giants now have 30 active players on their roster (16 pitchers, two catchers, seven infielders and five outfielders).

LEFT-HANDED MATCHUP: LHP Madison Bumgarner is 1-0 with a 0.60 ERA (1er, 15.0ip) and a .164 opponents average over his last two starts...he'll oppose LHP Tyler Anderson, who's struggled over his last three starts, going 0-3 with a 15.09 ERA (19er, 11.1ip) and a .429 opponents average...the Giants 27 wins when facing a left-handed starter are tied for the fourth-most in the Majors, while the Rockies 29 such wins are the third-most.

BUM VS. THE ROX: LHP Madison Bumgarner's career 2.93 ERA against the Rockies is the third-best mark against the Rockies all-time, behind Randy Johnson (2.47 ERA) and Johnny Cueto (2.67 ERA)...Bumgarner is 5-6 with a 3.93 ERA in 14 career games at Coors Field...the only two pitchers to never play for the Rockies and have a lower ERA at Coors Field are Ian Kennedy (3.16) and Tom Glavine (3.68) (minimum 10 starts) (*Stats, LLC*).

STARTING STRONG: Giants starting pitchers have each allowed three runs or fewer in 12 of their last 13 games, posting a combined ERA of 1.61 (15er, 83.2ip) and a .182 opponents average against...the starting staff has combined for a 1.20 ERA (7er, 52.1ip) in their last eight games.

INSIDE THE SERIES: Dating back to 2016, the Giants have dropped 15 of their last 17 games at Coors Field, including a 1-5 record this season...in their last series at this facility (July 2-4), SF scored just three runs in three games.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN: The Giants have been successful in 17 of their last 19 stolen base attempts, including each of their last 13 attempts.

NOTABLE MATCHUP: Rockies' OF Carlos Gonzalez is hitting .308 (20-for-65) and has slugged five home runs off **LHP Madison Bumgarner** in his career, more than any other player...his 20 hits are the second-most of any player off Bumgarner (ARI's Paul Goldschmidt: 22 hits) (*Stats, LLC*).

GIANTS AT COORS: IF Evan Longoria has hit safely in 11 of 12 games at Coors Field, batting .358 (19-for-53) with four doubles, three triples, five home runs and 14 RBI...**IF Brandon Belt** is a career .322 (57-for-177) hitter at Coors with 15 doubles, 10 home runs and 29 RBI...however, Belt has gone 26 plate appearances without an extra-base hit at Coors Field this season.

EARLY BIRDS: San Francisco has posted a 28-20 (.583) in the day games this year...their .583 winning percentage is the third-highest figure in the League.

SOLID PITCHING: Beginning June 1, Giants pitchers have posted a 3.25 ERA, which ranks as the best figure in the Majors (Dodgers are second with a 3.29 ERA).

This Date in Giants History: September 3, 1974

The Giants' **John Montefusco** made his Major League debut and homered in his first big league at bat off Charlie Hough...Montefusco also tossed 9.0 innings of relief to earn a 9-5 victory over the Dodgers.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner
6-4, 243, 29 years old (August 1, 1989)
5-5 Record, 2.68 ERA

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the mound this afternoon for his 17th start of the season...the Giants are 8-8 in his outings this year, going 5-3 at home and 3-5 on the road.
- Last pitched Tuesday vs. Arizona and spun 7.0 shutout innings in a no-decision with five strikeouts and four walks as the Giants' won, 1-0...was his fourth scoreless outing of 7.0 innings or more this season and first since August 7 vs. Houston.
- Matched up against Clay Buchholz in his last outing, marking the sixth straight time he's faced an opposing pitcher with either an All-Star Game appearance or a Cy Young Award on his resume...has faced Buchholz, deGrom, Matt Harvey, Clayton Kershaw, Dallas Keuchel and Zack Greinke in his last six outings.
- Has allowed three runs or fewer in 13 of his 16 starts.
- Bumgarner has an 0.94 ERA (5er/48.0ip) in innings 1-3 this season...he has a 4.27 ERA through the rest of the game...his OPS jumps 314 points (.457 vs .771 the first time vs. order compared to second time through the order).
- Has been given a total of just 28 runs of support in his 16 starts (2.50 RSA).
- Faces the Rockies for the third time this season...is 0-1 with a 1.38 ERA (2er, 13.0ip) in two starts...last faced Colorado on July 2 at Coors Field and allowed three runs, two earned, on eight hits over 6.0 innings in the Giants' 5-2 loss to the Rockies.
- With today's road start, it's worth noting his home/away splits (*Baseball Info Solutions*)...
 At home: 1.49 ERA, 2.8 K/BB, .191 BA, .555 OPS
 On road: 4.08 ERA, 1.9 K/BB, .265 BA, .793 OPS
- Is averaging 7.69 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, the lowest of his career since 2010...his 3.40 walks per 9.0 is the highest of his career.
- Will make his fourth daytime start this afternoon...is 2-0 with a 2.21 ERA (5er, 20.1ip) in his previous three daytime outings and has allowed one run over his last 15.0 daytime innings.
- Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5.
- Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- Had never been on the DL in his first eight MLB seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games...SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- His 109 career wins are the third-most in SF-era history (since 1958) behind **Juan Marichal** (238) and **Gaylord Perry** (134).
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36)...needs 38 strikeouts to match **Gaylord Perry** (1,606) for the fourth-most in SF-era history...is still seeking his first double-digit strikeout game this year (2018 season-high in strikeouts is eight).

HITTING NOTES: Is 4-for-33 (.121) with three RBI this year...batted .206 with three homers and five RBI last season...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968...has yet to homer in 2018.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP DERECK RODRIGUEZ

2018: 6-2, 2.47 ERA / Career: 6-2, 2.47 ERA

NOTES: 26-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 15th Major League start (17th appearance)...the Giants are 9-5 overall when he takes the hill as a starter, going 5-4 at home and 4-1 on the road...last time out vs. Arizona on August 29, Rodriguez surrendered three runs in 5.0 innings, snapping a streak of nine straight starts allowing two or fewer runs (6/24-8/24)...is making a strong case for National League Rookie of the Year honors, going 6-2 with a 2.47 ERA in 16 games (14 starts) this season...ranks second among rookie pitchers in ERA (2.47) and OPS (.619), is tied for third among NL rookies in wins (6), and second in opponents batting average against (.207)...his 2.47 ERA is the ninth-lowest among all MLB pitchers with at least 90.0 innings pitched.
