TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians enter play tonight at a high-water mark of six games over .500...Cleveland currently owns the largest divisional lead in MLB, a season-high 5.5-game cushion over second-place Detroit.
» **ADAM PLUTKO** has been recalled from Triple-A Columbus to make his fourth start of the season...he is seeking to become the first Indians pitcher to win each of his first four career starts since **Scott Lewis** did so in 2008...Plutko threw a no-hitter on June 2 in his most recent stint at Columbus, striking out eight batters and allowing just one baserunner on a 9th-inning walk.
» The Indians' six shutouts this season are tied with Houston for most in the American League (T5th in MLB)...the team's 25 shutouts since the start of 2017 are the most of any MLB club.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians opened their four-game set in Chicago with a 4-0 victory...marked the Tribe's sixth shutout win of the season and moved the team to a new high-water mark of six games over .500, increasing their division lead to a season-high 5.5 games.
» **LONNIE CHISENHALL** recorded his second straight three-hit performance, driving in the game's first run with an RBI-single in the top of the 4th inning...**YAN GOMES** capped the Tribe's three-run 4th and extended his hit streak to seven games with a two-run double that scored Chisenhall and **MELKY CABRERA** (0-2, 2BB).
» **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** went 1-for-5 and belted his 11th longball of the season with a solo homer in the top of the 5th inning.
» **CARLOS CARRASCO** earned his eighth win of the season in a dominant performance, allowing just two hits over 7.0 shutout innings...Carrasco walked one batter and fanned 11, reaching double-digit strikeouts for a second consecutive start...**ZACH McALISTER** (0.1IP), **OLIVER PÉREZ** (0.2IP) & **NEIL RAMÍREZ** (1.0IP, 2K) each contributed scoreless outings to complete the shutout.

SOUTH SIDE STORY

» The Indians and White Sox are meeting in Chicago this week in the second of six series between the clubs this season.
» The Indians previously hosted Chicago-AL in a three-game set at Progressive Field from May 28-30...the Tribe swept the three contests in Cleveland, outscoring the White Sox 25-10.
» Cleveland has won 16 of its last 20 games against Chicago-AL (since April 21, 2017), posting a 2.52 team ERA (50ER/178.1IP) in that span...the Tribe has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 15 of those contests.
» The Indians own an overall franchise record of 1064-1081 (.496) against the White Sox in a 118-year-old rivalry (1901)...since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013, Cleveland has gone 64-35 (.646) vs. Chicago-AL.

CENTRAL FOCUS

» Tonight's contest marks the fifth of 16 consecutive scheduled games against A.L. Central opponents, Cleveland's longest divisional stretch of the season...with the exception of the team's recent two-game set vs. Milwaukee, 23 of the Tribe's 25 contests from May 28 - June 20 are scheduled against divisional opponents.
» Cleveland has gone 17-9 thus far against the A.L. Central, going 5-2-1 across eight completed series...the club's .654 intra-divisional winning percentage is currently the 3rd-best in the American League (4th in MLB)...the Tribe is 6-7 in divisional road games, compared to 11-2 at Progressive Field.
» The Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 17 of their 26 divisional contests this season, going 15-2 in those games.

STARTING STRONG

» The Indians' starting pitching has been an asset throughout the season, and Tribe starters enter play today with a 3.39 ERA (2nd in A.L., 4th in MLB).
» Cleveland has posted 29 starts of 7.0-or-more innings this season, the most in MLB...**CARLOS CARRASCO's** performance last night gave the Tribe 42 quality starts on the season, 2nd-most in MLB behind Houston (49).
» Tribe starters rank 2nd in MLB with 414.0 innings pitched this season, yet they have allowed just 100 walks, the 3rd-fewest in MLB...the rotation's rate of 2.17 walks per 9.0 innings is the lowest among all MLB teams.

1943: The Indians use 19 players in an 11-inning, 7-6 loss at St. Louis-AL, leading to a number of players in unfamiliar roles...player/manager **Lou Boudreau** went 3-for-6 with two RBI and started at shortstop, and went on to make his first career appearance at catcher after the Tribe tied the game in the 9th to send it to extra innings...**Jim Bagby Jr.**, who would pitch a complete-game victory the next day, finished the game at shortstop for the Tribe.
