James Paxton's 1.05 WHIP this season is currently T3rd-lowest in a single season in franchise history (also: Hisashi Iwakuma in 2014 & Randy Johnson in 1997)...he trails only **Félix Hernández** (0.92 in 2014) and Iwakuma (1.01 in 2013).

5-1

Since April 16, **James Paxton** is 5-1 with a 2.47 ERA (16 ER, 58.1 IP) over his last 9 starts at Safeco Field...during this stretch he has limited opponents to a .176 (37x210) average, while walking 13 and striking out 79.

23-5

The Mariners are 23-5 this season when the starter goes at least 7.0 innings and 47-16 with the starting pitcher tosses at least 6.0 innings.

49

The Mariners have used 49 players this season, ranking T4th-most in the Majors this season (also: Baltimore, Milwaukee & Toronto)...trail only Los Angeles-AL (52), New York-NL (52) and Tampa Bay (50).

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 2-team, 7-day, 7-game homestand with the third of four games vs. the Toronto Blue Jays (0-2)...went 1-2 against Houston to open the homestand...following this series, will embark on a 2-state, 3-city, 10-day, 10-game road trip to Texas (3 G), Houston (4 G) and Oakland (3 G)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 8-16 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8-game straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 23 of their last 46 games, 30 of their last 55, 34 of their last 61, 39 of their last 67 and 41 of their last 71...Seattle is 50-35 in its last 85 games, 55-38 over its last 93 games and 60-42 in its last 102 games...Seattle is 20-18 during the day and 43-29 at night...Seattle is 35-23 at Safeco Field, 28-24 on the road.

- **Whiff** - **Edwin Díaz** has struck out his first batter faced 24 times this season, trailing only Adam Ottavino-COL (25) for most in the Majors...Díaz has struck out his first batter in 45.3% (24x53) of his appearances.
- **As Easy as 1-2-3** - **Edwin Díaz** retired the Astros in order in the 9th inning Monday for his 40th save of the season...in 24 of his 40 saves, he has faced the minimum 3 batters in an outing of exactly 1.0 inning, the most such saves in the Majors...Craig Kimbrel-BOS is 2nd with 17 saves of 1.0 inning and 3 batters faced.
- **First Things First** - **Dee Gordon** is batting .355 (33x93) with 21 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 walk and 2 HBP when leading off a game this season...his 33 hits to lead off a game are the most in the Majors.
- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 41-17 (.707) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 27-14 (.659) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 14-3 (.824) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 44-13 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 19-34 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 3 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (56-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining New York-AL (58-0) and Oakland (52-0).
- **Bullpen Bullies** - **Edwin Díaz** has not allowed an earned run over his last 14.0 innings spanning 14 appearances (6/25-c), while **Alex Colomé** has an active 12.2 scoreless innings streak over 13 games (6/30-c).
- **Milestone** - **Nelson Cruz** has hit 154 home runs in his Mariners career, currently 8th-most in franchise history...he is only 2 home runs shy of tying Raúl Ibañez (156) for 7th and 4 home runs away from Alvin Davis (160) for 6th in Mariners club history.

LOOKING BACK...**James Paxton** is making his first start vs. Blue Jays since throwing the 6th no-hitter in Mariners history earlier this season on May 8 at Toronto, marking the 5th no-hitter by an individual (one combined no-no by 6 pitchers)...it was the 1st complete game and shutout of Paxton's career...Paxton was the 2nd Canadian-born pitcher in MLB history to throw a no-hitter; also: Dick Fowler, PHI A's, vs. STL Browns, Sept. 9, 1945, Game 2...with the no-hitter he was the 1st American League pitcher to record a 16-strikeout game and a no-hitter in the same season since Nolan Ryan (TEX) accomplished this feat in the same game on May 1, 1991 vs. TOR...Paxton's no-hitter was the 4th Mariners no-hitter since 2012, tied with San Francisco for the most during that span...also marked the Mariners 1st no-hitter in club history to occur on the road.

ON A ROLL...dating back to May 2, **James Paxton** is 8-3 with a 2.95 ERA (31 ER, 94.2 IP) over his last 15 starts...during this stretch he has limited opponents to a .203 average (70x345) average, while walking 18 and striking out 119...during this stretch he ranks among American League leaders in WHIP (2nd/0.93), opponents batting average (.203), ERA (5th/2.95), strikeout (5th/119) and strikeouts per 9.0 innings (6th/11.31)...with a win today, Paxton would record his 2nd career 10+ win season (also: 12 wins in 17).

STREAKING...**Alex Colomé** has an active season-high 12.2 scoreless innings streak...during this stretch, dating back to June 30, he is 1-0 with 9 holds in 13 relief appearances...he has limited opponents to a .213 (10x47) average, while walking 4 and striking out 16...his 12.2 scoreless innings streak is the 6th-longest active streak in the Majors, while also ranking the 5th-longest by a Mariners pitcher this season...his active scoreless inning streak is the 3rd-longest in his career, trailing only a 21.2 innings streak (16 G, 8/4-9/5/15) and a 21.0 innings streak (19 G, 5/4-6/15/16).

THE EDWIN DÍAZ FILE...**Edwin Díaz** recorded his Major League-leading 40th save of the season on Monday...he becomes the 4th pitcher in single-season club history to notch at least 40 saves, joining Fernando Rodney (48, 2014), Kazuhiro Sasaki (45, 2001) and J.J. Putz (40, 2007)...Díaz has 87 strikeouts this season, 3 shy of setting a single-season career-high; he had 89 strikeouts last season after recording 88 punchouts in his rookie campaign of 2016 (appeared in 49 games after being called up to the Majors in June)...with his next strikeout, Díaz will join Dick Radatz (1962-64 w/BOS) as the only primary relievers in Major League history to record at least 88 strikeouts in each of their first 3 seasons.

WHAT A RELIEF...the Mariners lead the Major Leagues in saves (42) and rank 3rd in holds (78)...since 1973, only 6 clubs have led the Majors in saves and holds in the same season, most recently the 1992 Oakland Athletics...**Edwin Díaz** leads the Majors with 40 saves, while **Juan Nicasio** is T9th in MLB with 19 holds, and **Alex Colomé** is T11th with 18 holds.

ELECTRIC EDDIE...**Edwin Díaz** leads the Majors with 40 saves, while ranking 2nd among all relievers with 87 strikeouts (Josh Hader-MIL, 99)...of Díaz's 40 saves, 21 have come in 1-run games, most in the Majors this season (Craig Kimbrel-BOS, 12)...his 21 1-run saves are only 2 shy of equaling the Major League single-season record, set by Francisco Rodriguez in 2008 (23)...the Mariners are 48-0 when Díaz enters with a lead this season, including 23-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead...Díaz is 21-for-23 in 1-run save opportunities (91.3%) with a 0.77 ERA (2 ER, 23.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 5 walks.

HIT MACHINE...**Jean Segura** has reached base safely in 11 of his last 13 games vs. the Blue Jays, including 7 multi-hit contests, batting .375 (21x56) with 8 runs scored, 6 doubles, 1 RBI, 4 walks and 3 stolen bases...since 2016, Segura's .375 average vs. the Jays is the 5th-highest in the Majors, trailing only Josh Reddick (.404/19x47), Logan Forsythe (.400/26x65), José Altuve (.387/20x52) and Melky Cabrera (.378/17x45).

AS YOU KNOW...the Mariners are batting .280 (123x491) with 79 runs scored, 18 doubles, 3 triples, 15 home runs, 74 RBI and 35 walks in the first inning this season...**AND AS YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...dating back to July 3, the Mariners have scored 30 of their 84 runs in the first inning (35.7%)...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...**Dee Gordon** and **Jean Segura** each rank in the top 4 in the American League in runs scored in the first inning?...Francisco Lindor-CLE leads the American League with 25 runs scored in the first inning this season followed by **Gordon** (22), **Segura** (20), George Springer-HOU (20) and Brett Gardner-NYY (19).

ABOUT PAXTON...

- 29-year-old left-hander is making his 22nd start of 2018, his 96th career MLB start & 6th career start against the Blue Jays tonight.
- Selected by Seattle in the 4th round of the 2010 MLB June Draft.
- Native of Ladner, BC...attended Delta Secondary School.
- Pitched for the University of Kentucky, 2007-09...was 11-5, 4.91 ERA (81 ER, 148.1 IP) and 168 K's in 55 G/24 GS.
- Originally selected by Toronto in the Supplemental 1st round (39th overall) in the 2009 MLB June Draft, but did not sign.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.08 ERA (8 ER, 17.2 IP) in 4 starts with Grand Prairie in the Independent League in 2010.
- Pitched for the World squad in the 2011 MLB Futures game... named to Midwest League All-Star team in 2011.
- Pitched 6th no-hitter in Mariners history on May 8, 2018 at Toronto.
- Is 4-1 with a 2.45 ERA (18 ER, 66.0 IP) in 11 career GS in August.

LAST OUTING...W#9 in his return from the disabled list as the

Mariners shut out the Astros 2-0 on July 30...pitched an efficient 7.0 scoreless innings, needing just 82 pitches, and allowing just 3 hits and 0 walks while striking out 8 batters...after allowing a pair of singles in the 1st inning, retired 20 of the next 21 batters he faced.

HOME SWEET HOME...holds a 21-13 (.618) record in 46 career starts at Safeco Field...is 1 of 5 pitchers in franchise history with a winning percentage above .600 at home (min. 45 home starts)...ranks 4th overall, trailing only Randy Johnson (70-32/.686), Jamie Moyer (81-43/.653) and Gil Meche (31-19/.620).

LEADERBOARD...ranks 4th in the Majors with an 11.61 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings ratio (163 K, 126.1 IP)...his 7 games with 10+ strikeouts are 4th-most in the Majors, trailing only Max Scherzer-WAS (12), Chris Sale-BOS (10) and Trevor Bauer-CLE (9)...Paxton ranks 5th in the AL (8th in the Majors) with 163 strikeouts, trailing Sale (207), Bauer (195), Cole (194) and Justin Verlander-HOU (190).

THE RIGHT STUFF...has held right-handed hitters to a .191 batting average (72x376), while lefties have batted .304 (28x100) against Paxton this season...for his career, Paxton has limited righties to a .225 (384x1073) mark, with left-handers batting .282 (105x372).

HE'S BACK...activated from the 10-day disabled list on July 30...originally placed on the DL on July 13 with lower back inflammation.

NO-NO...pitched the 6th no-hitter (5th by a single pitcher) in Mariners history in Toronto on May 8...issued 3 walks, struck out 7 batters and needed just 99 pitches to accomplish the feat...recorded his 1st career complete game and 1st career shutout.

- Is the 2nd Canadian-born pitcher in MLB history to throw a no-hitter, joining Dick Fowler, who tossed a no-no for the Philadelphia Athletics vs. the St. Louis Browns in the second game of a doubleheader on Sept. 9, 1945.
- Became the first American League pitcher to record a 16-strikeout game and a no-hitter in the same season since Nolan Ryan achieved both in the same game on May 1, 1991 vs. Toronto with the Texas Rangers...STATS, Inc.
- Marks 4th Mariners no-hitter since 2012, tied with SF for most during that span.
- Marks the 3rd no-hitter in the Majors this season (Sean Manaea-OAK, 4/21 vs. BOS; four pitchers-LAD, 5/4 at SD in Monterrey, Mexico).

KKKKKKKKKKKKKKKK...recorded a career-high 16 strikeouts across 7.0 scoreless innings on May 2 vs. OAK...Paxton's 16 strikeouts are tied for the most in a single game in the Majors this season (also: Gerrit Cole-HOU, 5/4 at ARI)...marks the most strikeouts by a Mariners pitcher since Randy Johnson struck out 19 on 8/8/97 vs. CWS...became the first pitcher in Mariners history to record at least 2 strikeouts in each of the first 7 innings of a start.

WHIFF...recorded 49 strikeouts over his 5 starts from April 11 to May 2...is one of 5 Mariners pitchers in club history (done 65x) with at least 49 strikeouts over a span of 5 starts, the first since Félix Hernández also had 49 strikeouts over 5 starts, June 23 - July 14, 2012...Randy Johnson accomplished this feat 56 times while with the Mariners, followed by Mark Langston (4), Mike Moore (3), Hernández (1) and Paxton (1).

2017 SEASON RECAP...went 12-5 with a 2.98 ERA (45 ER, 136.0 IP) with 156 strikeouts and 45 walks in 24 starts... led club in wins (12) and strikeouts (156)...recorded a career-high 12 wins and 136.0 IP (previous: 121.0 IP in 2016)... spent 2 stints on the 10-day DL (5/3-30/17, 8/11-9/15/17)...went 6-0 with a 1.37 ERA (6 ER, 39.1 IP) with 46 strikeouts and 6 walks in 6 starts in July; named AL Pitcher of the Month...became the first pitcher in club history to earn 2 AL Player of the Week honors in a single season.

CAREER...is 38024 with a 3.33 ERA (203 ER, 548.1 IP) with 572 strikeouts in 95 career starts...has spent 8 years in the Mariners organization, including parts of 6 Major League seasons, after being selected by Seattle in 4th round of the 2010 MLB Draft...made MLB debut on Sept. 7, 2013 vs. TB.
