### TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** won the second of three against the Yankees in this series, their first win of the season against New York-AL, now 1-5 in 2018...are now 66-78 on the season and 42-31 at home...improve to 3-7 in September and are now 17-16 against the AL East this season...the 10 runs scored marked the most the Twins have scored against the Yankee's since July 24, 2015, when they won by a score of 10-1...Jake Cave's stolen base in the third inning was the first stolen base for the Twins since August 23 vs. Oakland.
- **TYLER DUFFEY** opened the game for the Twins and allowed one run on two hits over 2.0 innings...this was his longest appearance since August 18 at Detroit...this marked his 10th appearance allowing one-or-fewer runs to score.
- **JOE MAUER** (2-for-4) hit a grand-slam in the fifth inning, his sixth home run of the year and his fifth career grand slam, last September 17, 2017 vs. Toronto's Chris Rowley...his grand slam was on a full count, three of his five grand slams have come on a 3-2 count...was his second grand slam at Target Field...the home run was his 597<sup>th</sup> career extra base hit tying Rod Carew for fourth on the Twins All-Time List...with two runs scored tonight that bring his career total to 1,005 passing Clyde Milan for sixth of the Twins/Senators franchise list (since 1901)...with a single in the seventh inning, now has 34 multi-hit games on the season, second most on the team.
- **JORGE POLANCO** (3-for-5) extended his current hitting streak to three games, hitting .462 (6-for-13) during the streak...has hit in 16 of his last 20 games, hitting .316 (25-for-79) during that span...has recorded a hit in nine of 10 games vs. the AL East this season, including seven games in a row...hitting .355 (11-for-31) in those seven games...with a double in the fourth inning, his 14<sup>th</sup> of the season, he now has 16 multi-hit games this season and with a single in the fifth inning he recorded his first three-hit game since September 21, 2017 at Detroit.
- **JAKE CAVE** (2-for-5) recorded a two-RBI single in the third inning then stole second base, his second stolen base this season...the two-RBI mark his eighth multi-RBI game of the season...with another single in the fifth inning he recorded his 10<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season.
- **MAX KEPLER** (2-for-4) recorded a single in the second inning and a double in the sixth inning...the double was his 28<sup>th</sup> of the season and this marked his 24<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season.
- **WILLIAMS ASTUDILLO** (1-for-4) threw out Andrew McCutchen in the second inning at second base...this was his first CCS of his career.
- **KOHL STEWART** recorded his first career Major League win.

## **YANKEES NOTES:**

- **THE YANKEES** drop the second of three here at Target Field and are now 5-1 against the Twins this year...are 90-55 on the season overall and 23-10 against the AL Central...are 42-31 on the road now this season and are 17-42 when their opponent scores five-or-more...are 63-14 when scoring first this season and suffered just their 36<sup>th</sup> loss when recording a home run (80-36).
- **SONNY GRAY** suffered the loss after 3.0 innings and allowing three runs (two earned) on four hits...this marked his shortest start since August 1 vs. Baltimore (2.2 IP)...also marked the most runs scored since August 1 (7)...with three walks tonight he has now walked three-or-more batters in nine appearances this season.
- **DEDE GREGORIUS** (2-for-3) recorded his fifth triple of the year and first since August 17<sup>th</sup> in the first inning...hit his second grand slam of the season in the sixth inning off Trevor May, other was also against the Twins on April 23...was his third career grand slam...marked his 33<sup>rd</sup> multi-hit game of the season...has recorded a hit in five of six games this season against the Twins with six extra-base-hits...hitting .435 (10-for-23) against Minnesota this season.
- **ANDREW MCCUTCHEN** (1-for-2) recorded a single in the first inning and has safely hit in 10 of 12 career games against the Twins, hitting .396 (19-for-48) over those games.
- **MIGUEL ANDUJAR** (2-for-4) recorded a single in the fourth inning, extending his current hitting streak to four games, hitting .412 (7-for-17) during the streak...with a second single in sixth inning, marked his team-leading 48<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season...over his last 57 games, is hitting .330 (72-for-218) with 15 doubles, 40 RBI and 39 runs scored.
