PITTSBURGH PIRATES (31-33) vs. CHICAGO CUBS (37-24)

June 10, 2018 at Wrigley Field, Chicago, IL --- GAME #65/ROAD #32

RHP IVAN NOVA (2-5, 4.96 ERA) vs. RHP KYLE HENDRICKS (4-5, 3.59 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have lost three games in a row after beating the Dodgers on Wednesday...Have dropped six of their last seven games and 11 of their last 14...Have gone 5-16 in their last 21 games after their record was a season-high nine games over .500 on 5/17 (26-17)...Won a season-high five straight games on two occasions (4/25-29 & 5/6-12)...Were 29-35 after 64 games in 2017 (30-35 after 65).

NOTES ON NOVA: Ivan Nova is expected to make his 12th start of the season today and his first since 5/24...He has gone 0-4 with a 5.02 ERA (37.2ip/21er) in his last seven starts since winning his last decision on 4/15 at Miami...Nova posted a 3.32 ERA (38.0ip/14er) in his first six starts and has a 7.61 ERA (23.2ip/20er) in his last five.

A STRIKE THROWER: Over the last two seasons, only Clayton Kershaw (1.65) has a lower walks/per 9.0ip ratio than Ivan Nova (1.66) among National League pitchers...Nova has made 23 starts with the Pirates without walking a batter and has gone 11-8 with a 3.17 ERA in those games (the Bucs have gone 13-9-1 in those games).

PITCHING & DEFENSE: The Pirates have posted an 18-13 record and a 2.43 ERA (200.1ip/54er) this season when the starter has pitched 6.0 innings or more...The club is also 23-17 when it does not make an error in a game.

FEAST OR FAMINE: The Pirates are hitting .297 (322-for-1084) with 202 runs scored in their 31 wins (6.5 runs per game), while posting a 2.75 team ERA (288.0ip/88er)...In the team's 33 setbacks, the club has posted a .207 average (224-for-1084) with 88 runs scored (2.6 runs per game)...The pitching staff has a 5.79 ERA (281.1ip/181er) in the losses.

ROAD BUMPS: Since they blanked the Cardinals at Busch Stadium on 6/1, the Pirates have been held to a total of three runs and 17 hits in their last four games played on the road...The pitching staff has posted a 3.38 ERA (32.0ip/12er) in the last four road tilts, but the offense has produced a .142 batting average (17-for-120) and .194 OBP.

OFF TO ARIZONA: Following today's scheduled game, the Pirates travel to Arizona for the start of a three-game series tomorrow night...The Bucs went 2-2 in Phoenix last year, winning the last two games after dropping the first two during a four-game series in mid-May...The Pirates have gone 7-3 at Chase Field over the last three seasons and are 13-6 in their last 19 games played there, dating back to 4/17/12.

ROAD TRIP: Pittsburgh has gone 0-2 thus far on this six-game road trip...The Bucs have now lost seven of their last nine games played on the road after winning three straight between May 6-9...The trip concludes with three games in Arizona beginning Monday night...Overall the Pirates have produced a 13-18 record on the road this season.

IN GOOD COMPANY: Corey Dickerson has compiled a total of 179 hits prior to the All-Star break over the last two seasons...The only two players in the Majors with more in that time are Jose Altuve (207) and Charlie Blackmon (184).

GUNNING THEM DOWN: Francisco Cervelli has caught 10 runners attempting to steal this season; he had a total of nine last year...Among N.L. catchers, only Philadelphia's Jorge Alfaro has gunned down more runners this season (11).

ROOKIE RANKINGS: Bucco third baseman Colin Moran ranks second among National League rookies in batting average (.277), slugging percentage (.422) and OPS (.781)...He is also third in RBI (25) and third in total bases (73)...Moran has reached base safely in nine of his last 10 games and has tallied four hits in his last 12 at bats against LHP.

WHY DON'T WE STEAL AWAY: Starling Marte has swiped three bases in the last four games and has gone 13-for-16 in stolen base attempts this season...Marte enters today's action with 194 career stolen bases...Since 1900, only seven Pittsburgh players have recorded at least 200 career steals; Frank Taveras is seventh on the list with 206.

HOW MAY I ASSIST YOU?: Corey Dickerson recorded his fifth outfield assist of the season on Wednesday; a new single-season career high...Dickerson enters today tied for the third-most assists among all National League outfielders...Dickerson is also one of just seven outfielders in the league without an error (minimum of 50 games played); that list also includes teammate Gregory Polanco.

THE HIT MACHINE: Corey Dickerson currently ranks sixth among the National League leaders with a .321 batting average and is tied for fifth with 72 hits...Dickerson is batting .394 (13-for-33) during his current eight-game hitting streak and has produced a .382 (21-for-55) average in his last 15 games, dating back to 5/23.

ALL-STAR WORTHY: Francisco Cervelli enters today ranked first among all Major League catchers in OPS (.890), on-base percentage (.386) and second in slugging percentage (.503) behind Miami's J.T. Realmuto (.515).

CATCH THIS: Francisco Cervelli and Elias Díaz have combined to hit 12 home runs this season from the catching position (Cervelli also has a pinch-hit homer), which are tops among National League catching tandems and the most hit by Pittsburgh catchers since 2014 (13)...They combined to hit six in 2017, three in 2016 and seven in 2015.

OFFENSIVE OUTFIELD: Pittsburgh outfielders have combined to produce the best OPS among National League teams (.820) and the third-best among all Major League teams behind Boston (.897) and the New York Yankees (.820)...The Pirates outfielders also lead the N.L. in total bases (364), batting average (.281) and are second in RBI (105) behind Atlanta (106).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 10, 1977: It took 11 innings, but the Bucs defeated the San Diego Padres, 10-7, at Three Rivers Stadium. Willie Stargell hit a three-run homer in the bottom of the 11th inning scoring Dave Parker and Al Oliver. That was Stargell's only hit of the night. Rich "Goose" Gossage picked up the win for the Pirates after coming in during the 8th inning and pitching four scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and striking out four batters.
