NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees are 4-1 on their six-game homestand ... have won three straight games for the first time since winning four straight from 6/18-21.
 - At 68-37, are a season-high 31G over .500... is their first time reaching 31G over .500 since finishing the 2011 season 32G over .500 (97-65).
 - Are 38-15 (.717) at Yankee Stadium this season, including 33-10 since 4/21... have not lost any of their last 15 home series, going 12-0-3.
 - Are 45-6 (.882) when scoring first this season.
 - Are a Major League-best 42-6 (.875) when their starter tosses at least 6.0 innings.
- **Yankees batters** extended their streak to nine consecutive home games with at least 5R, their longest streak at the current Yankee Stadium... is tied for the longest streak in the Majors this season (Baltimore-9G, 4/26-5/12)... have scored 69R in 11 home games in July.
 - Homered in all 5G of this homestand (6HR total) after hitting just 1HR in their previous 5G.
 - Have nine sacrifice flies in the last seven games, and a Major League-leading 42 this season.
- **RHP Masahiro Tanaka** (6.0IP, 3H, 0R, 2BB, 8K, 1HP, 1WP) started and earned his ninth win of the season... extended his scoreless inning streak to 17.1 innings (since the fifth inning on 7/15 vs. Cleveland)... tied for the second-longest scoreless inning streak by a Yankee this season (Chad Green's 17.1 scoreless inning streak from 5/25-7/10; Dellin Betances' 17.2 scoreless inning streak from 5/27-7/7)... Tanaka's longest career scoreless inning streak was a 17.2 inning stretch from 8/13-30/16.
 - Has tossed back-to-back scoreless starts for the second time in his careers (also 2GS from 8/19-24/16).
 - Is 2-0 with a 1.76 ERA (30.2IP, 6ER) in his last five starts (since 6/8).
 - The Yankees are 12-5 in his 17 starts this season.
 - Is undefeated in his last 13 starts (since 4/23), going 7-0 with a 3.20 ERA (76.0IP, 27ER)... opponents are hitting .202 (55-for-272) over the streak... has allowed 3R-or-fewer in 10-of-13 starts... team is 10-3 during the stretch.
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (1-for-4) hit an RBI single in the first... the Yankees are 49-20 (.710) when he plays this season, and 19-17 in games without him.
- **SS Didi Gregorius** (2-for-3, 1R, 1RBI, 1BB) hit an RBI single in the third inning... has 17RBI in 25G this month after totaling just 13RBI in 47G over May and June.
 - Has reached base safely in each of his last 27 games vs. the Orioles (since 10/2/16), batting .398/.451/.676 (43-for-108) with 27R, 12 doubles, 6HR, 25RBI, 10BB and 4SB over that stretch... has recorded a hit in 26 of those 27 games.
- **LF Brett Gardner** (1-for-3, 2R, 1BB, 1SB) recorded his 251st career stolen base, tying Willie Randolph (251) for third-most in Yankees history.
- **3B Miguel Andújar** (1-for-4) hit a three-run home run in the fifth, his 13th HR of the season... marked his first HR since 6/29 vs. Boston.
 - Has 47 extra-base hits through his first 99 career games, the fourth-most in Yankees history through 99 games (Joe DiMaggio-69XBH, Bob Meusel-53XBH, Gary Sánchez-49XBH).
 - Has hit safely in 21-of-24 games in July, batting .330/.379/.443 (29-for-88) with 13R, 7 doubles, 8RBI, 6BB and 1HP.
- **RHP A.J. Cole** (1.1IP, 2H, 3R/2ER, 1BB, 2K) allowed 3R/2ER tonight after allowing only 2R in his first 13 appearances with the Yankees (21.2IP).
- **LHP Aroldis Chapman** (1.0IP, 3K) struck out all 3BF in the ninth to record his 29th save of the season... has struck out each of his last 7BF... has converted 22 consecutive save chances, the third-longest streak of his career (29 straight from 7/4/14-5/30/15 and 27 straight from 6/26-9/4/12).
- The Yankees drew their 21st sellout of the season, a single-season sellout record for the current Yankee Stadium (previous: 20 in 2011)... have 14 sellouts in the Yankees' last 18 home games.

BALTIMORE ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles began their three-city, nine-game road trip with a loss...snapped their three-game winning streak...are now 5-6 vs. the Yankees and 3-2 at Yankee Stadium this season...are 8-55 when scoring 3R-or-fewer this season.
 - Have now lost 11 straight *road* games (last road win was 6/23 at Atlanta)...are now a Major-League worst 12-40 on the road this season.
- **Orioles batters** failed to record a home run tonight after clubbing 14HR over their last seven games...are 4-33 this season when hitting 0HR.
- **RHP Yefry Ramírez** (5.0IP, 6H, 6ER, 3BB, 4K, 1HR, 1HP) faced his former organization for the second time this month (also 7/9-G2 at Baltimore)...allowed a career-high 6R (previous: 4, 7/9-G2 vs. Yankees)...has completed at least 5.0IP in four-of-six career starts.
 - In two starts this season vs. the Yankees, is 0-2 with a 10.00 ERA (9.0IP, 10ER)...is 1-2 with a 2.59 ERA (24.1IP, 7ER) in five games against all other opponents this season.
 - Has received 1R-or-fewer in support in five-of-six starts this season.
- **RHP Miguel Castro** (1.0IP, 1BB) threw a scoreless sixth inning tonight...has not allowed a run in his last 7.1IP (since the second inning on 7/15 vs. Texas), the longest active streak by an Orioles pitcher.
- **CF Adam Jones** (1-for-3, 1BB, 1K) extended his hitting streak to 10 games with his sixth-inning single...is hitting .410 (16-for-39) with 4R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 11RBI and 4BB over the span.
- **C Austin Wynns** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1K) had his first career multi-hit game and recorded his first career double.
- **2B Jace Peterson** (1-for-3, 1R, 1 double, 2RBI, 1K) doubled home two runs in the eighth...is his first multi-RBI game since 6/19 at Washington (also 2RBI).
