SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Jacob Nix** worked 0.2 IP in tonight's game, the first time this season in which a Padre starter did not get out of the first inning (previous fewest innings: Joey Lucchesi's 1.2 IP on June 20 vs. OAK).
- **Hunter Renfroe** belted his 13th homer of the season...owns a .589 SLG percentage vs. ARI in his career (five doubles and eight HR).
- **Travis Jankowski** has doubled in back-to-back games to lead off the game for the first time in his career...is hitting .353 (12-for-34) with a .436 OBP (five walks) in 14 games in August.
- **Cory Spangenberg** has at least one hit in eight of his last 10 games with an at-bat, batting .353 (12-for-34) since August 4...made his first career appearance at shortstop.
- **Kazuhisa Makita** tossed 3.1 innings of scoreless ball to set a career high IP (previous career-high: 3.0 IP on May 27 at LAD).
- **Trey Wingenter** struck out the side for the first time in his career.

ARIZONA NOTES

- **The Diamondbacks** sent 11 men to the plate in the first inning, their most in an opening frame since Aug. 3 vs. SF (also 11)...is tied for their fourth most in the first inning in team history.
 - Entering tonight, the D-backs had one game in franchise history that they scored five-or-more runs, all of which were scored in the first inning: Aug. 21, 2012 vs. Marlins (five runs)...is the third time this month the team has scored five-or-more runs in an opening frame and the second time this season in which they've scored five runs against the Padres in the first inning (also: July 7 at ARI).
 - The club's 103 runs scored in the first inning this season is the highest total in the majors.
- **Clay Buchholz** tossed his 10th career complete game and first since July 4, 2015 vs. HOU while with BOS...became the second D-back to throw a complete game this season (also: Patrick Corbin on April 17 vs. SF) and is the first pitcher to toss a complete game this year vs. SD (last: STL's Carlos Martinez on Sept. 4, 2017 in SD...was a three-hit complete game shutout).
 - Has allowed two or fewer runs in 12 of his last 15 road starts dating back to Aug. 18, 2016, posting a 2.49 ERA (25 ER, 90.1 IP) and a .221 opponent average in that time...in four starts vs. the NL West this season, is 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA (8 ER, 26.2 IP) and 28 strikeouts.
- **David Peralta** recorded his 22nd homer of the season to add to his career high...is batting .368 (14-for-38) with a double, a triple, five home runs and 10 RBI in his last nine games with a .842 SLG.
- **Paul Goldschmidt** has reached base in 35 consecutive road games since May 27, tying Eric Byrnes (Sept. 25, 2006- June 13, 2007) for the longest streak in team history...has reached base safely in 22 straight games overall since July 23, his longest since his 23-game streak from May 26- June 19, 2016.
 - Extended his hitting streak to nine games, batting .357 (15-for-42) over that span.
