WE IN MIAMI: The Padres topped the Atlanta Braves 3-1 on Wednesday afternoon, winning the second of the three-game set and claiming their third consecutive series...it was the second-straight rubber game the Padres have won this year (now 3-6), and tonight, the Friars look to take their straight consecutive series vs. Elisabeth Schmidt's Miami Marlins (won three of four from May 28-31 in SD)...the Padres finished their last home stand 7-3, having won seven of their last nine games and nine of their last 14.

- Starter **Matt Strahm** worked a season-high 2.1 innings in his fifth-career start, allowing just two hits and one run (earned) without walking a batter.
- Relievers **José Castillo**, **Adam Cimber**, **Kirby Yates** and **Brad Hand** combined for 6.2 innings and allowed just one hit and not a single run while fanning 11...Yates was credited with his ninth hold of the season, Hand got his team-leading 18th save and Castillo earned his first-career win.
- **Cory Spangenberg** logged his second triple of the season, and he now has four extra-base hits in his last four games (two triples and two homers).

A SERIES OF FORTUNATE EVENTS: The Padres have won three-straight series (since May 28) for the first time since last season, when they took two of three from CLE, PHI, SF (July 4-16)...the Padres have slashed .263/.336/.425 in that time with 5.3 runs per game and 37 walks...the San Diego bullpen has a .256 opponent average in that span, allowing one of 10 inherited runners to score...the last time the Friars have won four consecutive series dates back to August 10-23, 2015 (vs. CIN, @COL, vs. ATL and vs. STL), in which they went 9-3.

PRINCE ERIC TAKES THE HILL: When starter **Eric Lauer** works 5.0-or-more innings, he owns a 2.05 ERA (5 ER, 22.0 IP) with a .278 opponent average and a 1.45 WHIP...when he tosses less than 5.0 innings, he has a 15.32 ERA (21 ER, 12.1 IP) with a .456 opponent average and a 2.92 WHIP...he enters tonight's game having most recently claimed his second-career win vs. CIN on June 2...a win tonight would be the first time in his career that he'd claim back-to-back starts.

SOMETHING SMELLS FISHY: The Friars look to continue their recent success against the Marlins, owning a 3-1 record vs. the Fish this season...the Friars slashed .246/.324/.392 vs. MIA in 2018 and hit .286 with RISP (8-for-28).

THE YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS: SD rookies have seen 212 games played by the team's rookies, the second-most games played of any team this season...the Marlins, in fact, are the only team to have more games played by rookies (220).

UNDER PRESSURE: San Diego has a .283 batting average (65-for-230) with RISP/2 out...it's the highest mark in the majors this season in such a scenario...however, the Friars are hitting .217 with nobody on and nobody out, the fourth-lowest mark in the big leagues.

WHERE YOU LEAD, I WILL FOLLOW: The Padres are 21-17 (.553) when **Eric Hosmer** records a hit, compared to 6-16 (.273) when he goes hitless...he also has a .496 OBP in wins and a .261 OBP in losses...his .235 difference in OBP is the third-highest of any player this season (MIL's Christian Yelich has a .265 difference and CHC's Addison Russell has a .236 difference).

SLIDE TO THE LEFT, SLIDE TO THE RIGHT: **Brad Hand** has a .355 opponent OPS this season against his slider, good for the second-lowest mark of any pitcher this season (minimum 250 sliders thrown)...Hand throws his slider 54.7 percent of the time (sinker 23 percent and four-seamer 22.2 percent)...MIA's Caleb Smith has a .299 opponent OPS vs. his slider, the best mark of any pitcher this year.

PADRES ON DECK: Yesterday for San Antonio (AA), **Fernando Tatis Jr.** hit a two-run home run, his 11th of the season...it was his eighth homer since the start of May, and he has hit .347 in that time.

#46 LHP ERIC LAUER (2-3, 6.82)

LAUER HOUR: 23-year-old **Eric Lauer** (who just had his birthday this past Sunday) is set to make his ninth career start and second this season against the Miami Marlins.

- Tied his career low for innings pitched (2.1) in his previous outing against the Fish on 5/28, allowing five runs on a career-high-tying seven hits (4x).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second career win on 6/2 vs. CIN, tossing 5.0 IP of one-run ball, striking out four and walking two in the Padres' 8-2 victory...a win tonight would be the first time in his career that he'd claim back-to-back starts.

GET TO 5.0: When Lauer works 5.0-or-more innings, he owns a 2.05 ERA (5 ER, 22.0 IP) with a .278 opponent average and a 1.45 WHIP...when he tosses less than 5.0 innings, he has a 15.32 ERA (21 ER, 12.1 IP) with a .456 opponent average and a 2.92 WHIP.

V SUPPORTIVE: When the southpaw rookie gets two-or-more runs of support from the Padres offense (happened in four of his eight starts), he is 2-0 with a 3.48 ERA (8 ER, 20.2 IP) and a 1.60 WHIP with just one home run allowed.

ERIC'S ARSENAL: Lauer has relied on four pitches this season: four seamer (63%), cutter (20.6%), curve (10.4%), changeup (6.1%).

WINS VS. LOSSES: Lauer owns a .082 ERA (1 ER, 11.0 IP) with a .267 opponent average in the two wins he's accrued this season...he has a 23.1 ERA (25 ER, 23.1 IP) and a .382 opponent average in his three losses.

PICKOFF ARTISTS: **Lauer** (five) and fellow rookie lefty **Joey Lucchesi** (three) have combined for eight pickoffs this season... it's the most pickoffs by a Padre duo in franchise history, ahead of **Clayton Richard** and **Josh Geer** six combined pickoffs in 2009.

- Lauer's five pickoffs ranks tied for the ML lead with SEA Marco Gonzales and ATL Julio Teheran's.
- The Padres 11 pickoffs lead the majors, ahead of Atlanta's 10.

LEARNING LESSON: Allowed a career-high seven runs (six earned) on seven hits and a walk in the Padres' 9-5 defeat on 5/11 vs. STL.

- Became the first Padres starting pitcher since Ben Howard on Sept. 14, 2003 at LAD to allow three home runs in an inning, which occurred in the top of the third.

SPLITS IT UP: Lauer has walked three left-handed batters this season and yielded 14 free passes to right-handed hitters...lefties have also accrued just two RBI off the southpaw, while righties have combined for 24 RBI.

HISTORIA: Earned his first career win on 5/6 vs. LAD in Monterrey, Mexico, tossing 6.0-shutout innings behind a career-high 102 pitches and five strikeouts against one walk in the Padres' 3-0 victory.

- Became the first and only SD pitcher to get his first career ML win in a game played outside the US and Canada...also just the second starter to get such a win and the fifth pitcher (starter or reliever) to do so.
- At 22 years and 337 days old on 5/6, he was the fifth-youngest pitcher in the NL to record a win this season.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

TYSON'S TURN: RHP **Tyson Ross** is scheduled to make his 13th start of the season tomorrow in Game 2 of this three-game set at Marlins Park.

- Is 1-1 with a 3.50 ERA (7 ER, 18.0 IP) in his three career starts vs. the Marlins...it will be his first career start (second appearance) at Marlins Park.
- Earned the win in his last outing on 6/3 vs. CIN... it was his third win in his last four outings and the Padres have won each of his last five starts.
- Has worked 5.0 IP or more in 11 of his 12 starts, including seven quality outings.

- Is scoreless in 11 of his 15 relief appearances this season, posting a 1.80 ERA (6 ER, 30.0 IP) out of the Padres bullpen.
- Tossed 5.2-scoreless innings on May 28 vs. MIA, his longest relief appearance in his career...is the first Padres reliever to throw 5.2-or-more scoreless frames in a single outing since Josh Banks on May 25, 2008 vs. CIN.
- Has not issued a walk in each of his last 11 appearances since April 23 at COL...his 11.50 strikeout/walk ratio ranks second among NL relievers, behind only WSH Sean Doolittle (13.00).
- Made two starts for the Padres in 2018...is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

- His 18 saves rank fourth in the majors and second in the National League...converted each of his 11 save opportunities during the month of May, tied with BOS Craig Kimbrel for the most in MLB.
- Since trading closer Brandon Maurer on July 24, 2017, his 36 saves in that time rank second in MLB, behind only SEA Edwin Diaz (37).
- According to Statcast data, 51% of his pitches this season have been sliders...13.9% of his sliders are called strike, the second-highest percentage across Major League relievers.
- Was named the National League Reliever of the month for May, the second such honor of his career (also, July 2017)...pitched to a 0.61 ERA (1 ER, 14.2 IP) during May with a 0.89 WHIP, 22 strikeouts and a .120 opponent average.
- Joined Trevor Hoffman as the only two Padre pitchers (third time) in team history to record 11-or-more saves during the month of May (Hoffman had 12 saves in 2005 and 11 saves in 2007).
- Is just the fourth reliever in Padres history to tally 11 saves in a single month, joining Craig Kimbrel (July 2015), Trevor Hoffman (May 2007, September 2006, May 2005, July 2004, July 1998) and Mark Davis (September 1989, April 1989).
