**THE TWINS:** Beat the Rays yesterday afternoon in Port Charlotte by a score of 6-5...Aaron Slegers (1-1) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on five hits in 3.0 innings pitched...Fernando Romero pitched 3.0 perfect innings of relief with two strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, two coming from Erick Aybar and two from Ryan LaMarre.

**TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER:** Phil Hughes will be making his third start of the spring tonight in Tampa...in his last start he allowed four runs on five hits, two home runs, and one walk while striking out one in 2.1 innings March 3 at Toronto...last spring, he made six starts, going 1-2, 6.55 ERA (22.0 IP, 16 ER) with five walks and 12 strikeouts...last season, Hughes started nine games, combining to go 4-3, 5.87 ERA (53.2 IP, 35 ER) with 13 walks and 38 strikeouts...placed on the disabled list July 18 with recurrence of thoracic outlet syndrome and missed the remainder of the season...the veteran has started 77 games over four seasons in Minnesota, going 32-29, 4.37 ERA (477.2 IP, 232 ER) with 58 walks and 352 strikeouts...Hughes was originally drafted by the Yankees in the first round (23rd overall) in the 2004 MLB draft out of Foothill High School in Santa Ana, CA...he is in his 12th major league spring training.

**TWINS AND YANKEES:** Tonight marks the first of two meetings with the Yankees this spring, the other will be on March 22 at Hammond Stadium...the Twins did not play the Yankees in 2017 spring training with their last game being on March 27, 2016 at George M. Steinbrenner Field...the Twins and Yankees split that spring, each team winning at their home park.

**LAST TIME WE MET:** The last time the Twins played the Yankees was in the AL Wild Card game on October 3 at Yankee Stadium...Ervin Santana was the starter, allowing four runs on three hits in 2.0 innings pitched...the Twins scored three runs in the first inning on home runs by Brian Dozier (solo) and Eddie Rosario (2-run)...the Yankees answered with three runs in the bottom half, scored four more runs in the next four innings as the Twins eventually lost 8-4.

**THIS AND THAT ON AYBAR:** Erick Aybar signed a minor league deal with an invite to spring training on February 21...Twins would mark his fifth organization: Los Angeles-AL (2002-15), Atlanta (2016), Detroit (2016) and San Diego (2017)...he appeared in 108 games for the Padres last season, hitting .234 (78-for-333) with 15 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI and a .300 on-base percentage.

**NOTES ON KINLEY:** Tyler Kinley is in his first spring training with the Twins...spent 2017 in the Marlins organization, split the season between Single-A Jupiter and Double-A Jacksonville...combined to go 2-3, 3.54 ERA (53.1 IP, 21 ER) with 22 walks and 72 strikeouts in 50 games...held left-handed hitters to a .231 average and right-handers to a .205 average...selected by Minnesota 20th overall in Rule 5 Draft December 14...became the 13th player from Barry University to ever be drafted professionally, most notably Yan Gomes by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2009.

**RG36:** Robbie Grossman is in his second spring training with the Twins and 10th of his career: Pittsburgh (2009-12), Houston (2013-15) and Cleveland (2016)...he appeared in a career-high 119 games last season, posting a .361 on-base percentage, which ranked second on the club, trailing Joe Mauer (.384)...since the start of 2016, he ranks second in all of baseball in on-base percentage (.372), trailing only Dexter Fowler (.378).

**UNDER THE LIGHTS:** The Twins are playing their fourth of seven scheduled night games this spring (next: March 16 at Boston, 6:05 pm)...the Twins are 1-1-1 in night games this spring beating the U of Minnesota 2-1 on February 22, tying the Orioles in Sarasota 1-1 on February 24 and losing to the Red Sox at home on February 27, 2-3...the Twins went 28-33 in regular season day games in 2017 and 57-44 in night games.

**FIRST TIME CAMPERS:** The following players are appearing in major league camp with the Twins for the first time: pitchers - Alan Busenitz, John Curtiss, Zach Duke, Dietrich Enns, Trevor Hildenberger, Myles Jaye, Tyler Kinley, Michael Kohn, Zack Littell, Gabriel Moya, Jake Odorizzi, Michael Pineda, Addison Reed, Fernando Rodney, and Lewis Thorpe...catchers: Willians Astudillo, Brian Navarreto, Jordan Pacheco and Bobby Wilson...infielders: Erick Aybar, Taylor Featherston, Logan Morrison, Gregorio Petit and Brock Stassi...outfielders: Nick Buss, Chris Heisey, Ryan LaMarre and LaMonte Wade.

**ROLL CALL:** The Twins have 53 players in camp (15 non-roster)...26 pitchers (3 non-roster), five catchers (5 non-roster), 13 infielders (5 non-roster) and nine outfielders (4 non-roster)...the oldest player in camp is Fernando Rodney (born 3/18/77) at 40-years-old.
