### TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** took the final game of the four game set against the White Sox and improve to 6-3 against Chicago this year...have won nine of their last 12 and 15 of their last 22 against the White Sox...face the White Sox again on June 26 for a three-game series in Chicago...improve to 13-8 in the division...the Twins are now 5-3 on the current 11-game homestand and are 16-15 at Target Field this year...Eddie Rosario and Robbie Grossman both recorded outfield assists, and the Twins now have seven outfield assists in the last 14 games, the most in baseball over that stretch...are 20-8 when their starter goes 6+ innings this year and are 23-1 when leading after eight innings...shortest game of the season for the Twins (2:14).
- **JOSÉ BERRÍOS** earned his team-high seventh win after throwing a complete game, allowing two runs on six hits with nine strikeouts...second career complete game, his other on April 1 against Baltimore (he has both this season for the Twins)...his third 10+ strikeout game of the year and his first since May 15 vs. St. Louis (5th of career)...retired the first 14 batters of the game before allowing a double to Omar Narvaez in the fifth inning...his fifth straight outing of 6.0+ innings, the longest streak of his career...his seventh quality start of the year, which leads the team...his fourth start without allowing a walk and his first since April 18 vs. Cleveland...season-high 109 pitches.
- **EDUARDO ESCOBAR** (2-for-4) hit a two-run home run in the first inning and has now hit safely in eight of his last nine games...over his last nine games, six of which have been multi-hit games, hitting .441 (15-for-34) with five home runs, 15 RBI...has 36 extra-base hits this season, fourth most in the AL...has now hit safely in seven straight games against the White Sox and has reached safely in his last 12...third time in his career he's reached 12 home runs in a season, tied for second most of his career (21 in 2017 and 12 in 2015).
- **EDDIE ROSARIO** (2-for-3) hit a three-run home run in the fourth inning and doubled in the first, his 23rd multi-hit game this season; entered the day seventh in multi-hit games in the AL...since May 1, hitting .364 (52-for-143) with 12 doubles, 11 home runs, 31 RBI and 27 runs scored...recorded an outfield assist in the fifth inning, his second in as many games.
- **BEHIRE ADRIANZA** (1-for-3) hit a solo home run in the second innings and is hitting .320 (6-for-25) with four doubles, two home runs and four RBI over that stretch.
- **BRIAN DOZIER** (1-for-4) singled and drove in a run in the third to extend his hitting streak to six games, hitting .368 (7-for-19) during the streak.

### WHITE SOX NOTES:

- **THE WHITE SOX** drop the fourth of four games against the Twins and fall to 3-7 in their last 10 games at Target Field dating back to 2017...are 9-16 against the AL Central and have lost 16 of their last 23 against the division...are 10-21 on the road this year and are 17-31 in their last 48 divisional road games...are 2-2 on the current road trip and finish the trip with three games in Boston.
- **JAMES SHIELDS** suffered his seventh loss of the season after allowing seven runs on eight hits, three of which were home runs, with two walks...has allowed six home runs in his previous two starts; prior to his June 2 start against Milwaukee, had only allowed four this season...his 12th straight start with either a loss or a no decision, the longest streak of his career.

- **JOSE ABREU** (1-for-4) recorded an RBI-single in the sixth to extend his current hitting streak to seven games, hitting .310 (9-for-29) during the streak...now has 35 RBI in 41 career games at Target Field.
- **YOAN MONCADA** (1-for-4) doubled and drove in the first run of the game for the White Sox in the sixth inning...now has a hit in eight of his last nine games, hitting .243 (9-for-37).
- **OMAR NARVAEZ** (2-for-3) recorded two doubles, his second multi-hit game of the year, first since April 28 vs. Kansas City.
