ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 15-8 on the road, going 5-2-0 in series play....the team had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (245-258) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #45 - RHP JHOULYS CHACÍN (9gs, 3-1, 4.00)

CHACÍN AT A GLANCE: Jhoulys Chacin, 30, is making his 10th start of the season....Chacin last started last Thursday at Colorado and earned a 5-2 win (5.1ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr)....he is 3-0 with a 2.87 ERA over his last 6 starts (31.1ip, 10er)....the team has gone 7-2 in his starts this season, including 5 straight wins....he has made 2 quality starts....opponents are batting .256 (44-for-172, 5hr)....Chacin signed as a free agent on 12/21/17....he is signed through the 2019 season....his name is pronounced "yo-LEASE sha-SEEN"....bio is on p. 81 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Chacin went 13-10 with a 3.89 ERA in a career-high 32 starts with San Diego....his 13 wins and career-high 153 strikeouts led the team....he held opponents to a .235 batting average (157-for-667, 19hr), which ranked in the NL....the Padres went 18-14 in his starts....he had 16 quality starts, tying Luis Perdomo for the team lead, going 10-3 with a 2.05 ERA in those starts (105.1ip, 24er)....Chacin went 9-5 with a 2.93 ERA over his last 20 starts (116.2ip, 38er).

CAREER: Is 62-68 with a 3.94 ERA in 204 games / 176 starts (1068ip, 467er)....is in his 10th Major League season....has pitched for Colorado (2009-14), Arizona (2015), Atlanta (2016), LA of Anaheim (2016), San Diego (2017) and Milwaukee (2018).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 1-2 with a 3.65 ERA in 6 starts (37ip, 15er)....prior to this season had not pitched at Miller Park since 2014....is 1-1 with a 2.04 ERA in 3 starts this season (17.2ip, 4er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 25-38 with a 4.32 ERA in 101 games / 84 starts (493.1ip, 237er)....was 4-7 with a 6.53 ERA in 16 starts in 2017 (80ip, 58er)....is 2-0 with a 5.27 ERA in 6 starts this season (27.1ip, 16er).

CAREER vs. D-BACKS: Is 6-4 with a 3.48 ERA in 17 games / 16 starts (93ip, 36er)....was 1-1 with a 5.21 ERA in 3 starts last season (19ip, 11er)....is 2-3 with a 4.46 ERA in 7 career starts against the D-backs at Chase Field (40.1ip, 20er)....Chacin pitched for the D-backs in 2015.

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .189 (55-for-291) hitter with 1 HR....homered on 9/20/13 vs. Arizona (2-run off Randall Delgado)....has 7 walks and 65 strikeouts.
