Let's Touch Base

Christian Yelich has reached base safely in 19 straight games (since 8/11), which is the longest active streak in the National League....he is batting .318 (27-for-85) with 9 HR and 21 RBI over this stretch.... during the recent 6-game road trip, he batted .444 (12-for-27) with 4 HR and 14 RBI, which included his first career multi-HR game (Tuesday at Cin), hitting for the cycle (Wednesday at Cin) and his first career grand slam (yesterday at Wsh).

An MVP-Like Season

Christian Yelich ranks among National League leaders in batting average (2nd, .316), runs (2nd, 96), OPS (3rd, .940), slugging percentage (4th, .559), hits (4th, 155), total bases (4th, 274), extra-base hits (6th, 60), on-base percentage (9th, .381) and HR (19th, 27).

AT HOME: The Brewers are 40-26 at home, going 12-6-3 in series play....after a 2-6 start, the team is 38-20 over its last 58 home games....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22 and a season-high 3-game home losing streak from 4/7-4/16....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 37-35 on the road, going 11-8-4 in series play....had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11 and a season-high 6-game road losing streak from 7/11-7/15....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (297-302) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 27 replay challenges, going 5-22....their last challenge (lost) came on 8/30 at Cincinnati as a safe call at home plate involving Phillip Ervin stood....went 17-27 in 44 replay challenges last season.

TODAY'S STARTER: #27 - RHP ZACH DAVIES (8gs, 2-5, 5.23)

DAVIES AT A GLANCE: Zach Davies, 25, is making his ninth start of the season and third against the Cubs....the team is 2-6 in his starts....he has made 3 quality starts....opponents are batting .274 (45-for-164, 7hr)....Davies was on the 10-day disabled list from 5/3-5/23, retroactive to 4/30, with right rotator cuff inflammation and again from 6/1-8/23, retroactive to 5/30, with the same injury....he was optioned to Class-A Wisconsin following his second stint on the DL and tossed a shutout last Monday at Clinton (9ip, 7h, 0bb, 6k, 85 pitches).... Davies was acquired from Baltimore on 7/31/15 in exchange for OF Gerardo Parra....bio is on p. 84 of the media guide.

LAST SEASON: Davies went 17-9 with a 3.90 ERA in 33 starts....he led the team in wins for the second straight season....his 17 wins tied Zack Greinke for second in the National League, trailing only Clayton Kershaw (18)....his 33 starts tied for the NL lead (with three others) and 191.1 innings pitched ranked ninth....the team went 20-13 in his starts....he produced 15 quality starts, going 10-3 with a 1.44 ERA in those starts (100.1ip, 16er)....opponents batted .275 (204-for-741, 20hr)....he went 7-4 with a 5.40 ERA over his first 15 starts (78.1ip, 47er) and 10-5 with a 2.87 ERA over his last 18 starts (113ip, 36er).

CAREER: Is 33-23 with a 4.04 ERA in 75 starts for the Brewers (431.2ip, 194er)....made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2015.

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 16-16 with a 4.84 ERA in 42 starts (239.2ip, 129er)....is 1-3 with a 5.33 ERA in 5 starts this season (27ip, 16er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 17-7 with a 3.05 ERA in 33 starts (192ip, 65er)....is 1-2 with a 5.06 ERA in 3 starts this season (16ip, 9er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Is 5-5 with a 3.64 ERA in 12 starts (71.2ip, 29er), including 0-1 with a 2.31 ERA in 2 starts this season (11.2ip, 3er).
