2015 SUMMARY

Midseason All-Star

- Pitched for five different teams in 2015, beginning with Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa in Chicago-NL system.
- Pitched eight games for Sugar Land of the independent Atlantic League after being released by Chicago on May 29.
- Signed by Atlanta as Minor League free agent on July 7 and appeared for Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett; made first appearance with Atlanta organization on July 10 with Gwinnett.
- Did not allow an earned run over 17 relief appearances between Gwinnett and Mississippi.
- Registered 31 strikeouts over 20.2 innings pitched between the two Atlanta stops, while earning the win in one contest, on August 17 vs. Toledo.
- Posted multiple strikeouts in nine of his 17 outings with Mississippi and Gwinnett.
- In 17 appearances with Atlanta affiliates, limited opposing left-handed batters to a .154 average.
- Over his final four outings of the season, with Gwinnett, struck out 12 of his 29 batters faced.

CAREER MINOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS

- Earned Southern League Midseason All-Star honors in 2014 with Double-A Tennessee; went 2-2 with 2.67 ERA (27.0 ip/8 er) in 20 appearances over the first half, with 12 walks and 35 strikeouts.
- Ranked second in league with 14 holds and his 48 appearances led team.
- Held lefties to .151 mark (11x73) with five extra-base hits; walked eight while fanning 26.
- Righties batted .228 (33x145) against him.
- Went 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA (12.1/2) in nine April outings; did not allow his first run until sixth outing, on April 20, via a home run, his only home run allowed on the season.
- Held opponents scoreless in 32 of 48 outings.
- Opened 2013 with Single-A Daytona and posted 2.91 ERA (21.2/7) in 11 outings, with five saves, earning first career promotion to Double-A.
- Set a career high with six wins between Daytona and Tennessee; combined to post 3.00 ERA (60.0/20) in 41 appearances.
- Allowed six runs over first two outings with Tennessee, but settled in to post 1.78 ERA (35.1/7) in final 28 appearances.
- Finished season with 11 consecutive scoreless outings (13.0 ip).
- Held lefties to a .115 average (6x52) with Tennessee.
- Opened 2012 in Boston system with Single-A Greenville before joining Cubs on May 15 as PTBNL in Marlon Byrd trade that was completed one month prior.
- Combined to go 3-3 with a 4.31 ERA (62.2/30) in 35 relief appearances between Greenville, Single-A Peoria, and Single-A Daytona.
- First appearance in the Cubs' organization came May 18 with Peoria, when he allowed four runs (one earned) over 1.2 innings.
- Did not allow a run over his next seven appearances (12.2 ip).
- All three of his wins came with Peoria, as he went 3-0 with a save and a 2.54 ERA (28.1/8) in 15 relief outings.
- At Daytona, lefties batted just .136 (3x22) against him.
- Fanned 19 batters in 18.2 IP with Daytona, while allowing eight earned runs (10 runs total) for a 3.86 ERA.
- In 2010, ranked fifth among Boston's Minor League pitchers with a 3.59 ERA (62.2/25) for Short-Season A Lowell; struck out 55 and allowed just two home runs.
- Surrendered two runs or fewer over his final six starts for Lowell.
