**THE LOSS:** The Royals have lost six of seven games and four straight, clinching their 11th series loss of the season (now 1-11-2).  
 + Have lost consecutive series vs. Tampa Bay (1-2 from Aug. 28-30, 2017) for the first time since June 2-Aug. 3, 2009 (3 straight) and have lost consecutive series vs. the Rays at Kauffman Stadium for the first time in club history...they're 4-7 vs. the Rays since Aug. 3, 2016 after going 25-6 in their previous 31.  
 + Dropped to 6-15 at Kauffman Stadium this season...they've posted a winning record here in each of the previous five seasons (2013-17), going 227-178.

**IAN KENNEDY:** Remains winless in his last seven starts, going 0-4 with a 6.43 ERA (25 ER in 35.0 IP) since his last win on April 7 in Cleveland.  
 + Allowed the Rays to bat around in the three-run first inning, going: single, two-run home run (**C.J. Cron**), line out, double, walk, RBI single (**Adeiny Hechavarria**), strikeout, walk, strikeout to strand the bases loaded...stranded a one-out hit in the second, but allowed a leadoff double in the third to score on a sacrifice fly (**Mallex Smith**)...retired eight straight and 12 of his last 14, allowing a two-out walk in the fifth and a double to leadoff the sixth, which scored on **Jesús Sucre's** sac. bunt RBI...exited after 6.0 innings, trailing 5-3...pitch count by inning: 34 (1st), 18 (2nd), 8 (3rd), 11 (4th), 13 (5th), 17 (6th), 101 total.  
 + Struck out his final batter to end the sixth, the 1,500th strikeout of his career, becoming the 16th pitcher currently on a 40-man roster to reach that mark.

**KELVIN HERRERA:** Surrendered the go-ahead run in the ninth on **Joey Wendle's** RBI single, the first run he's allowed at home since Sept. 8, 2017 vs. Minnesota—his last loss before tonight—snapping his home scoreless streak at 11.0 innings (12 appearances)...entered with one run allowed in 14.2 innings overall in 2018.

**WHIT MERRIFIELD:** Had an RBI single in the fifth inning and the game-tying two-run single in the seventh to extend his hitting streak to nine games, in which he's batting .457/.513/.657 (16-for-35)...it's his sixth career hit streak of at least nine games, breaking a tie with **Alcides Escobar** for most on the team since his debut in 2016.

**HUNTER DOZIER:** Singled and scored in the fifth inning and doubled and scored in the seventh to mark his first career multi-hit game (entered 4-for-22 in the Majors).

**RAYS:** Are 6-3 in their last nine series and have won consecutive games for the first time since May 4-5, and for the first time on the road since April 25-28 (4 straight).  
 + Have won consecutive series vs. Kansas City (2-1 from Aug. 28-30, 2017) for the first time since June 2-Aug. 3, 2009 (3 straight) and have won consecutive series at Kauffman Stadium for the first time in club history...they've won three straight games vs. the Royals for the first time since July 24-Aug. 11, 2011 (5).  
 + Improved to 10-12 on the road, including 10-7 since starting with five straight losses...they're 3-3 on this 11-game, three-city road trip to Baltimore (1-3), Kansas City (2-0) and Anaheim (May 17-20), their third of four straight three-city trips and their first trip to three different time zones since June 3-11, 2008.  
 + Tonight marked the 600th straight Rays game started by a pitcher under the age of 30, the longest current streak in the Majors...the Rays' last 30-plus starter was 35-year-old **Erik Bedard** (July 3, 2014 at Detroit)...they've used an under-30 starter in 1,835 of 1,909 games (96.1%) of games since June 26, 2006.  
 + Batted around in the *first inning* (3 runs) for the first time since May 9, 2017 vs. Kansas City (4-run 1st)...they've scored in the first in four of the last five games.  
 + Improved to 7-12 in one-run games...nineteen of their 40 games (47.5%) have been decided by one run, most in the Majors.

**ANTHONY BANDA:** Made his Rays debut and became the eighth starting pitcher used by Tampa Bay this season, matching the club's 2017 total...eight different starters match the most in team history through 40 games (also: 2015, '05, '03, '01, '00 & '99) and are tied for second most in the Majors in 2018, trailing the Angels (9).  
 + He's just the 34th different starting pitcher used by Tampa Bay since 2008, fewest in the Majors ahead of San Francisco (36) and Cleveland (40).  
 + Stranded a one-out single in the first inning on an inning-ending double play (6-4-3), and allowed a double and a single to leadoff the second, but only one scored (RBI groundout)...retired his next nine batters before allowing back-to-back singles to leadoff the fifth, followed by a sac. bunt, RBI groundout and an RBI single (**Whit Merrifield**)...exited after 5.0 innings, leading 5-3...pitch count by inning: 7 (1st), 20 (2nd), 5 (3rd), 8 (4th), 12 (5th), 52 total.

**JONNY VENTERS:** Recorded the last two outs of the eighth inning ahead of the Rays' rally in the ninth to earn his first win since Aug. 17, 2012 vs. the Dodgers (with Atlanta), 2,096 days ago...in between his wins, 1,059 different pitchers recorded a win in the Majors.

**JOSÉ ALVARADO:** Recorded a scoreless sixth inning, but was charged with the tying runs in the seventh, both of which scored on **Whit Merrifield's** two-run single *after* he exited in favor of **Sergio Romo**...the runs snapped his scoreless streak at 6.2 innings (8 appearances), the first he's allowed since April 22 vs. Minnesota...also snapped his scoreless streak *on the road* at 15.1 innings (18 appearances), the first he's allowed since June 14, 2017 at Toronto.  
 + Charged with two runs in a season-high 1.2 innings tonight, matching the two runs he allowed in his previous 21.2 career innings on the road (0.83 ERA).

**JOEY WENDLE:** Had the game-winning RBI single in the ninth, his second career go-ahead RBI in the ninth or later (RBI double on Oct. 1, 2016 at Seattle in the 10th).

**C.J. CRON:** Hit a go-ahead, two-run home run in the first inning, his team-leading ninth HR and second on this trip (Saturday in Baltimore)...extended his career-high on-base streak to 21 games, in which he's batting .310/.358/.598 (27-for-87), the second longest by a Ray in the last four years behind **Logan Morrison** (27) in 2017.

**JESÚS SUCRE:** Had an RBI sacrifice bunt in the sixth inning, the first run-scoring sac. bunt by the Rays since **Daniel Robertson** did it on April 30, 2017.

**MATT DUFFY:** Exited in the bottom of the fifth inning with right hamstring tightness...he is day-to-day.

**CARLOS GÓMEZ:** Exited in the bottom of the sixth inning with right groin tightness...he is day-to-day.
