RED HOT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 28-15 post All-Star Break and 29-15 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in MLB since the All-Star Break (28) and rank 2nd in winning percentage (.651), trailing Oakland (.659) over that period. St. Louis has won 18-of-their-last-24 games overall, including a season-best eight-game winning streak from August 7-15. Entering July 15, the Cardinals had 19th-most wins in the National League (47) and currently have the 3rd-most wins (77) in the N.L.

HAPPY LABOR DAY: The Cardinals are 90-102-3 on Labor Day (39-73-1 on the road) since it became a national holiday in 1894. The only time the Cardinals played Washington on Labor Day was September 4, 2006 at RFK Stadium, a 4-1 loss to the Nationals. That afternoon, **Ramón Ortiz** held the Redbirds hitless through 8.0 innings before **Aaron Miles** singled to open the ninth inning. Later in the inning after a double play, **Albert Pujols** hit his 43rd home run of the season, a solo shot to chase Ortiz from the game. St. Louis has an overall record of 7-6 against the Montreal Expos on Labour Day (2-2 on the road).

BREBBIA RECALLED: Prior to today's series opener in Washington, the Cardinals recalled right-hander **John Brebbia** from Memphis (AAA). Since being optioned on August 20, Brebbia made five relief appearances with the Redbirds, going 1-0 with 3.18 ERA (5.2 IP/2 ER) and 10 strikeouts.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals are at 15 games over .500 entering play today and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 5.5 games out of first place and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 0.5 games. The Cardinals currently carry the 3rd-best record in the National League and have 3 games remaining against the only team ahead of them in the standings, the Chicago Cubs.

YOUNG GUN: Jack Flaherty leads all MLB rookies with his team-leading 149 strikeouts (12th in the N.L.), while his 169 career strikeouts in first 28 career games are the most ever by a Cardinal. The 22-year-old's 10.96 strikeouts/9 IP, is currently on pace for the highest in Cardinals history (**Rick Ankiel**, 9.98, 2000) and ranks 4th all-time in MLB history among rookies (see box right).

YOUTH PREVAILS: The Cardinals current probable starting rotation has a combined 5 years and 43 days of Major League Baseball Service time and 88 career starts. **Miles Mikolas** leads the list with 2.011 years and 37 starts, with **Jack Flaherty** (28 starts; 0.138), **John Gant** (23 starts; 1.136), **Austin Gomber** (7 starts; 0.071) and **Daniel Ponce-deleon** (3 starts; 0.031) rounding out the crew.

DANCING IN SEPTEMBER: The Cardinals have posted the best stretch of winning Septembers since the turn of the decade in 2010 going 135-98 (.579) in the month, trailing only Cleveland (.581) in MLB.

WAINWRIGHT CONTINUES SCORELESS REHAB: Saturday night, **Adam Wainwright** pitched 5.0 scoreless innings scattering five hits with two walks and a season-high seven strikeouts for Memphis (AAA). Wainwright threw 90 pitches (63 strikes) and has recorded 17.0 scoreless innings over six rehab starts at three different minor league levels.

WITHIN STRIKING DISTANCE: Cardinals outfielder **José Martínez** ranks T4th in the NL batting title race with a .310 batting average. **Scooter Gennett** of the Reds currently leads the Senior Circuit with a .319 average. The last Cardinal to lead the NL in batting was **Albert Pujols** (.359) in 2003. Martínez's .310 career batting average ranks 12th in Cardinals history among players with 800 or more PA.

ROOKIE REINFORCEMENTS: The Cardinals have received 22 wins from rookie pitchers this season including 12 wins from rookies in the month of August. **Austin Gomber** won five games, **Jack Flaherty** won four and **Dakota Hudson** won three. Tampa Bay received 10 wins from five different rookies last month and no other MLB team was closer than five.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (Sept. 3, 2001): In only his 11th Major League start, 21-year-old **Bud Smith** tosses a no-hitter to defeat the Padres, 4-0, in San Diego. Smith threw 134 pitches, walked four, and struck out seven. A native of Southern California, Smith's mother, stepfather, 14 immediate family members, and 10 high school buddies were among those in attendance.

WASHINGTON CONNECTIONS

Tyson Ross' younger brother, **Joe Ross**, is a pitcher for the Nationals (2015-17).

Cardinals pitcher **Brett Cecil** was born in Dunkirk, Md...graduated from DeMatha High School in nearby Hyattsville...2004 NBSBCA and Maryland Louisville Slugger Player of the Year...pitched three seasons at the University of Maryland (2005-07)...left school as the Terrapins single-season (13) and career saves (23) leader and single-season appearance leader (30).

Matt Adams played in 94 games for the Nationals this season before the Cardinals claimed him off waivers (August 21, 2018).

Tyler Webb was born in Nassawadox, Va...graduated from Northampton High School in Eastville, Va.

John Gant made his Major League debut against the Nationals (April 6, 2016) while with the Atlanta Braves...his first career MLB strikeout was Wilson Ramos (swinging).

Cardinals pitching coach **Mike Maddux** served in the same role with the Nationals for two seasons (2016-17)...also pitched parts of two seasons (1998-99) for the Expos.

Cardinals bullpen coach **Bryan Eversgerd** pitched in 25 games for Montreal in 1995.

Greg Holland appeared in 32 games for St. Louis this season.

Max Scherzer is a native of Chesterfield, Mo...graduated from Parkway Central (Mo.) High School...originally selected by the Cardinals in the 43rd of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign...pitched at the University of Missouri (2005-07).

Mark Reynolds played in 140 games for the Cardinals in 2015.

Cardinals Senior Special Assistant to the GM **Bob Gebhard** was a player/coach in the Montreal organization from 1974-75, then coached in Montreal's system through 1986, including on

the Major League coaching staff in 1982.

Nationals Bench Coach **Chip Hale** played in 132 games for Memphis (AAA) in the Cardinals organization during his final season (1998).

Nationals Pitching Coach **Derek Lilliquist** spent 16 years in the Cardinals organization, serving as St. Louis' pitching coach (2012-17), bullpen coach (2011-12), minor league pitching coordinator (2008-10), and pitching coach for Palm Beach (2004-07), Peoria (2003), and pitching coach and Johnson City (2002).

Nationals broadcaster **Bob Carpenter** worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals on both radio and television before joining Washington...graduated from nearby McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister, **Judy Carpenter-Barada**, serves as the Cardinals Director of Major League Administration.

Nationals broadcaster **Charlie Slowes** worked three years at KMOX (1984-86).

- Rookie makes his 23rd start of the season & 29th career appearance (28th start).
- Is 4-1 in 7 day game starts, posting a 2.19 ERA (9th N.L.) & .173 Opp. BA (9th N.L.).
- Has struck out 62 batters post All-Star Break, 5th among National League pitchers.
- Leads all MLB rookies and the Cardinals with his 149 strikeouts (12th in the N.L.).
- His 169 strikeouts in first 28 career games are the most ever by a Cardinal.
- Ranks among N.L. rookie pitching leaders in batting average (.193, 2nd), wins (8, 1st), strikeouts (149, 1st), ERA (2.87, 2nd), innings (122.1, 2nd) and starts (22, 2nd).
- Among NL starting pitchers, ranks 2nd in batting average (.193), trailing only the Nationals Max Scherzer (.179), 6th in WHIP (1.02), and he's 4th in K/9 IP (10.96).
- Nine of the 12 runs he's allowed over his last eight starts have come via home run.
- Has the 2nd-lowest ERA in the N.L. of pitchers who have allowed 16 or more home runs this season (Scherzer 2.22).
- Ranks T7th among NL pitchers with nine hit batsmen, including four Cubs batters
- Since May 20, has struck out 135 batters in 19 starts, 3rd-most among NL pitchers.
- Has received one run or less of support in 7 of his starts & 2 runs or less in 13 starts.

- Won his 4th-straight decision in 5-2 win vs. PIT last Tue. (8/28). It was his 2nd start of the season with no walks allowed.

- Has limited the opposition to one run or fewer in 13 starts this season (T5th N.L.), and four or fewer earned runs in all 22 of his starts.
- Finished August 4-0 with a 1.13 ERA in 5 starts, becoming the 5th rookie starter in the last 30 seasons with 4+ wins and an ERA below 1.20 in a calendar month (*Elias*).
- Held the Dodgers hitless over his first 5-1/3 innings on 8/22 before allowing Joc Pederson solo HR in the 6th, his lone hit allowed. Struck out 10, taking ND in 3-1 STL win. It marked his seventh-straight start with 7 or more strikeouts; first Cardinal to do so since Chris Carpenter (7 straight, June 8-July 17, 2005).
- Earned his 2nd-consecutive win on 8/11 at KC, limiting the Royals to just 3 hits (2-run HR in 5th were lone runs allowed) in 7.0 innings of work while fanning nine.
