HERE'S THE STORY

- ♦ The D-backs are 23-14 (.622) since May 28, the second-best NL record behind only the Dodgers (.657; 23-12).
- ♦ Arizona is 16-8 in its last 24 home games vs. Padres.
- ♦ **Robbie Ray** is 4-0 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER in 31.2 IP), .136 opponent average, 48 strikeouts, 13 walks and in his last 5 outings vs. Padres since Aug. 20, 2016.
- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** is batting .388 (45-for-116)/.478 OBP/.767 SLG with 9 doubles, 1 triple, 11 homers, 28 RBI and 19 walks in his last 29 games.
- ♦ **Nick Ahmed** has reached base in a career-high-tying 10 straight games (June 26-present; also: April 20-May 1, 2018; June 8-19, 2015), hitting .324 (12-for-37)/.818 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 RBI and 2 walks.
- ♦ **Jake Lamb** has reached base safely in 14 straight games since June 19, tied for the third-longest streak of his career (also: June 28-July 17, 2016).

- ♦ Double-A RHP **Yoan López** (World Team) has been named to the MLB All-Star Futures Game on July 15 @ Nationals Park.
- ♦ López has gone 2-4 with 6 saves, a 3.38 ERA (14 ER in 37.1 IP), .187 opponent average and 55 strikeouts (13.3 SO/9.0 IP) in 27 games with the Generals...in his last 6 appearances, he has posted a 0.90 ERA (1 ER in 10.0 IP) and 17 strikeouts.
