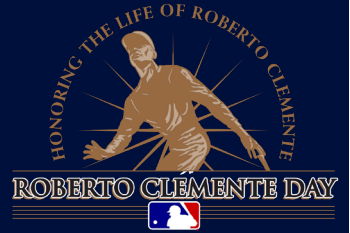

WE LIKE DESERT W'S: The Padres toppled the Arizona Diamondbacks 6-2 last night in the first game of the brief two-game set in Phoenix...the Padres have now won five of their last seven games...starter **Bryan Mitchell** worked 5.0 innings and allowed just one run (earned) on two hits, receiving his first win as a Padre and his first win as a starter since Sept. 7, 2016...it was just the second occasion in his career in which he worked 5.0-or-more innings and allowed two hits or fewer (Sept. 28, 2016 vs. BOS)...**Franmil Reyes** propelled the Padres offence with his first-career multi-homer game.

MEJÍA MOVES: Today, the Padres recalled C **Francisco Mejía** from El Paso (AAA)...Mejía will wear No. 27, and there are now 29 players on the active roster.

AND THE PADRES' ROBERTO CLEMENTE NOMINEE IS...: The Padres have nominate LHP **Clayton Richard** for the Roberto Clemente Award...previously dubbed the "Commissioner's Award" in its establishment in 1971, it was renamed in 1973 after Roberto Clemente's tragic death on New Year's Eve, during a plane crash while attempting to deliver supplies to earthquake victims in Nicaragua...the award recognizes the player who best represents the game through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions.

THE ROOKIE REVOLUTION: The Padres have seen 53 rookies get the start this season (54 including **Joey Lucchesi's** start tonight), which entering the game, rank second-most in the majors behind TB's 57 and MIA's 60.

PROTECTED FROM THOSE RAYS: Friars with notable numbers vs. opposing starter **Robbie Ray:** **Eric Hosmer** (500, 3-for-6 with two homers), **Freddy Galvis** (.313, 5-for-16), **Jose Pirela** (.333, 3-for-9 with one double and one homer) and **Cory Spangenberg** (.333, 3-for-9 with one double and one homer).

THE FIRST WEALTH IS GOOD HEALTH: The Padres bullpen has a 3.09 ERA since the break, the best mark in the NL and second-best in the majors (OAK's 2.68 ERA).

#FRANIMAL: Last night, **Franmil Reyes** had his first-career multi-homer game, extending his career high hitting streak to nine games (.407, 11-for-27)...Reyes has now homered in three of his last five games and has hit six homers in his past nine games (owns a ML-leading 1.541 OPS since Aug. 25).

GONE STREAKIN': **Hunter Renfroe** is riding a career-high 11-game hitting streak, batting .348 (16-for-46) since August 23 @ COL with two doubles, five HR and 11 RBI...it's the longest active hitting streak among NL players (behind just SEA's Mitch Haniger's 15-game streak for the longest in the ML)...the 11-game spree ties with **Christian Villanueva** for the longest by a Padre this season (Villanueva had his from April 13-28).

PADRES ON DECK: Last night for El Paso (AAA), C **Francisco Mejía**, the Padres' No. 3 prospect, went 2-for-4 with a double and two runs scored...he was 8-for-14 over the final three games of the Pacific Coast League season with a double, a triple, two homers, with five RBI and six runs scored to finish with a .328 average...for Fort Wayne (A), 2B **Esteury Ruiz**, the Padres' No. 17 prospect, was 3-for-4 with a stolen base to finish the season with a .253 batting average and 49 steals...for Lake Elsinore (A), 2B **Eguy Rosario**, 19, was 4-for-5 with a stolen base and two runs scored, finishing with a .239 average.

THIS DATE IN PADRES HISTORY: On Sept. 4, 2004, **Tony Gwynn's** No. 19 was retired by the Padres during ceremonies at Petco Park.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#37 LHP Joey Lucchesi (7-7, 3.59)

IT'S JOEY TIME: 25-year-old **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make the 22nd start of his career and his fifth against the Arizona Diamondbacks...is in search of his first win against the D-Backs, having been tagged with the loss in each of his four outings against Arizona with a 7.71 ERA (16 ER, 18.2 IP).

LAST TIME OUT: Improved to 7-7 after his last start on August 29 vs. SEA, setting career highs in innings pitched (6.2) and pitches thrown (108) in SD's 8-3 victory...also matched his career high with nine strikeouts (3x).

GET TO 6.0: He has reached the 6.0 inning mark on five occasions...in those starts, he is 4-0 with a 1.17 ERA (4 er, 30.2 ip)...the Padres are 4-1 in those starts.

OFF TO THE RACES: Is one of just 19 rookies to have reached the 20-start plateau in Padres franchise history...prior to Dinelson Lamet (2017) and Luis Perdomo (2016), the most recent Friar rookie arm to do so was Justin Germano in 2007...his 21 starts rank tied for fifth among rookies this season.

SINCE YOU'VE BEEN BACK: In his 12 starts since being reinstated from the 10-day DL with a right hip strain on June 20, he is 4-5 with a 3.88 ERA (25 er, 58.0 ip), allowing two earned runs or less in nine of those 12 outings and holding opposing bats to a .249 clip.

NO WALKS FOR YOU: Lucchesi's 37 walks allowed this year are tied for seventh-fewest of any NL hurler who has made at least 21 starts.

AWAY FROM HOME: Is 2-2 with a 2.89 ERA in his seven starts away from Petco, with his only two road losses coming here at Chase Field...opponents are slashing line of .225/.285/.362...in his 14 starts at Petco, he has posted a 3.97 ERA and a .260/.332/.446 line.

REACHING...: Among all pitchers who have made at least 21 starts this season, Lucchesi has allowed the fifth-fewest base runners (139).

COMING UP CLUTCH: With RISP this season, Lucchesi has a .235 opponent average (16-for-68) with three extra-base hits allowed (one double and two homers)...opponents have a .286 OBP in such scenarios.

- Opponents are hitting .182 (6-for-33) with runners in scoring position and two outs.

PICK ME BABY ONE MORE TIME: Joey has recorded three pickoffs and fellow rookie lefty **Eric Lauer** leads the majors with 10...their 13 combined pickoffs are the most by a Padres rookie duo in franchise history, and the Padres 19 pickoffs in total lead the majors.

SHOWING HE BELONGS: The Padres selected Lucchesi to the Major League roster to start the club's second game of the season on March 30...he went on to allow three earned runs or fewer in eight of his first nine career outings from March 30-May 14, posting a 3-2 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 er, 47.1 ip) and 9.13 SO/9 IP.

- Missed 32 games from May 14-June 20 with a right hip strain, and he went 1-3 with a 3.60 ERA over his final five starts of the first half, limiting hitters to a .187 average.

THROUGH FOUR, UNDER 2.00: Lucchesi logged a 1.66 ERA through his first four starts with a 2-0 record...the last SD pitcher to have a sub-2.00 ERA over his first four MLB starts was **Odrisamer Despaigne** in 2014 (1.35).

FIRST IN CLASS: Made his Major League debut on March 30 vs. MIL, becoming the first pitcher of the 2016 draft class to make it to the show...he was the second player overall drafted in 2016 to make it to the majors, following only Orioles **OF Austin Hays**....teammate **Eric Lauer** became the second pitcher of the '16 class to make his MLB debut (April 24 at COL)

- Made just 39 minor league starts prior to his big league debut, going 11-9 with a 1.99 ERA (40 er, 181.0 ip).

LOOK BACK AT IT: The left-hander was named Padres Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2017 after pitching to a combined 11-7 record with a 2.20 ERA (34 er, 139.0 ip), 148 SO against 33 walks and a .200 opponent average in 24 appearances (23 starts) between Lake Elsinore (A) and San Antonio (AA).

THURSDAY'S STARTER — #46 LHP Eric Lauer (5-7, 5.01) — @e_lauer10 

LONGING FOR SOME LAUER: LHP **Eric Lauer** was reinstated from the 10-day disabled list (left forearm strain on 7/31) and made his 19th career start and second against the Colorado Rockies on 8/30...tossed 5.0 IP of hitless ball behind 81 pitches in the Padres' 3-2 victory.

- In his last 12 starts since 6/2, Lauer has posted a 3.75 ERA (26 ER, 62.1 IP)...allowing three earned runs or less in 10 of his 12 outings.
- Relied on five pitches this season: four-seamer (60.2%), cutter (19.9%), curve (11.2%), slider (5.1%) and changeup (3.6%).

- Has only appeared as a starter for the Padres this season, tossing 5.0 innings-or-more in four of his nine starts...his next relief appearance will be his first since June 10, 2016 at COL.
- Has relied on four pitches: Sinker (45.3%), Slider (25.4%), Four Seamer (17.6%), Split Finger (11.7%).

- Owns a 71.5 first-pitch strike percentage and is limiting opponents to a .226 batting average on the season overall.
- His 2.86 career ERA during the month of September is his lowest during any single month in his career (min. 55.0 IP).

- At 37-years-old, his .291 clip this season is the highest in his career...his .387 OBP is the highest among all ML catchers with at least 50 games played.
- Has three multi-hit effort in his past four starts (.375, 6-for-16).
- Slashing .309/.407/.397 on the road this year and .276/.391/.355 at home.
- His seven runners caught stealing are the most since he caught eight in 2015.
