**RECENT RESULTS:** The Tigers dropped the series opener to the Cubs, 5-3, on Tuesday afternoon at Wrigley Field. Mikie Mahtook had three hits and scored a run in the game, while Niko Goodrum and James McCann each added a hit and a RBI. Michael Fulmer started for Detroit and received a no decision after giving up three runs on seven hits with three walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings. Daniel Stumpf took the loss in relief, allowing a run on two hits with one strikeout in two thirds of an innings. The Tigers conclude their six-game road trip this afternoon with the series finale vs. the Cubs. Following today's game, Detroit returns home for a four-game series vs. Texas (July 5-8).

**START ME UP:** Michael Fulmer recorded a quality start in yesterday's game, allowing three runs on seven hits with three walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings. Tigers starting pitchers have now thrown 6.0-or-more innings in seven consecutive games, which is their longest streak since August 1-7, 2014, when they also had seven straight starts of at least 6.0 innings. Over their last nine games, Tigers starters have compiled a 3.00 ERA (57.0IP/19ER) and 44 strikeouts. Detroit ranks third in the American League with a 3.00 ERA during that time span.

**LOOKING FOR THE LEFTY:** Today's game marks the 23rd time this season that the Tigers will face a lefthanded starting pitcher. Detroit has gone 13-9 against lefty starting pitchers so far this season, and is hitting .275 (193x702) as a team against southpaw hurlers. The Tigers lead the American League with a .275 batting average vs. lefties, while they are third with a .436 slugging percentage and fourth with a .332 on-base percentage. Individually, Nicholas Castellanos ranks second in the Majors with a .430 (34x79) batting average vs. lefties.

**TIGERS AND CUBS:** The Cubs have a 1-0 lead in the season series against the Tigers after yesterday's win. After today's game at Wrigley Field, the two teams will resume the season series in Detroit on August 21-22. The Tigers and Cubs last met in 2015, when Detroit won three-of-four games. All time, Detroit is 16-6 against Chicago (NL), including winning nine-of-12 games at Wrigley Field.

**INTERLEAGUE INTRIGUE:** The Tigers are 1-8 in Interleague play this season. Detroit has a 207-185 (.528) record vs. National League opponents since Interleague play began in 1997. Only eight other Major League teams have at least 200 wins in Interleague history (New York (AL), Boston, Los Angeles (AL), Oakland, Texas, Chicago (AL), Minnesota, Seattle). Over the last 13 seasons (since 2006), the Tigers are 136-99 (.579) in IL play, which ranks fourth among all ML teams over that stretch, trailing only the Boston Red Sox (156-77, .670) and New York Yankees (141-99, .588).

**ON THE ROAD:** The Tigers are 2-3 on their current six-game road trip, which includes four games at Toronto (2-2) and two games at Chicago (NL) (0-1). Detroit is currently in a stretch that will see them play 20-of-28 games away from Comerica Park leading up to the All-Star break. The Tigers are 15-28 on the road this season. As a team, Detroit is hitting .236 (350x1483) on the road in 2018, while the pitching staff has compiled a 4.67 ERA (364.1IP/189ER).

**ON DECK:** The Tigers return home tomorrow to begin a four-game series against the Texas Rangers. Texas holds a 2-1 lead in the season series after winning two-of-three games in Arlington earlier this season. Detroit

has lost the season series to the Rangers five times in the last six seasons, with the Tigers only series victory coming in 2014. Detroit has dropped eight of its last nine games vs. Texas played at Comerica Park.

**NOTES ON THE SKIPPER:** Ron Gardenhire is in his first season as the Tigers manager after being named to the position on October 20, 2017.

\*Enters today's game with a 38-49 (.437) record as the Tigers manager and a 1,106-1,088 (.504) career record as a manager, which is the eighth-most wins among active managers and ranks 54th in baseball history.

\*Earned the 1,100th win of his managerial career on June 13 vs. Minnesota.

\*Spent the 2017 season as the bench coach for the Arizona Diamondbacks, who captured a National League Wild Card spot and advanced to the National League Division Series.

\*Served as manager of the Minnesota Twins from 2002-14 and is the winningest manager in Twins history, posting a record of 1,068-1,039 (.507) over his 13 seasons...is one of 10 managers in baseball history to win 1,000-or-more games with a single team.

\*Guided the Twins to six postseason appearances (2002-04, 2006, 2009-10), including a berth in the 2002 American League Championship Series...was the first manager in MLB history to guide his team to the postseason in six of his first nine seasons.

\*Named the BBWAA American League Manager of the Year in 2010...also finished runner-up for the honor on five occasions.

**SIGNED, SEALED AND DELIVERED:** The Tigers have agreed to terms on Minor League contracts with five players during the international signing period, including a pair of MLB Pipeline.com's top-20 international prospects in OF Jose De La Cruz (#15 prospect) and SS Adinso Reyes (#19 prospect). **ABOUT FRANCISCO:** Liriano will make his 13th start of the season this afternoon in the series finale at Chicago (NL).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Liriano turned in a quality start, but suffered his third consecutive loss on Friday at Toronto, allowing three runs on seven hits with four walks and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

**VS. CHICAGO (NL):** Liriano has made 14 career starts against the Cubs, posting a 5-4 record with a 3.27 ERA (82.2IP/30ER) and 99 strikeouts. He last faced Chicago (NL) on July 8, 2016 and did not factor into the decision after giving up two runs, one earned, on three hits with three walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

**ON THE ROAD:** Liriano has made 169 career appearances, including 144 starts, on the road, posting a 52-60 record with one save, a 4.43 ERA (820.2IP/404ER) and 813 strikeouts. In seven road starts this season, Liriano has a 1-3 record with a 3.05 ERA (41.1IP/14ER) and 25 strikeouts.

**AT WRIGLEY FIELD:** Liriano is making his eighth career start at Wrigley Field this afternoon. In seven previous starts in Chicago, Liriano has a 4-3 record with a 3.60 ERA (45.0IP/18ER) and 54 strikeouts.

**INTERLEAGUE ACTION:** Liriano has pitched in 40 games, including 35 as a starter, in his career in Interleague play, compiling a 17-13 record with a 3.94 ERA (212.2IP/93ER) and 208 strikeouts. He made four relief outings in Interleague play last season and went 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA (4.0IP/0ER) and one strikeout.

**RECORD IN JULY:** Liriano has made 53 starts in his career during the month of July, posting a 24-15 record with a 3.62 ERA (310.2IP/125ER) and 329 strikeouts. In six July starts last season, Liriano went 2-2 with a 6.75 ERA (26.2IP/20ER) and 20 strikeouts.

**LEFT VS. RIGHT:** Liriano has limited lefthanded batters to a .217 (307x1412) batting average in his career, while righties have hit .248 (1207x4874). In 12 starts this season, lefties are hitting .100 (5x50) and righthanded batters are hitting .250 (47x188) against Liriano.

**IMPRESSIVE START TO 2018:** Liriano began the season by allowing three runs-or-fewer in each of his first seven starts. The streak was his second longest to start a season in his career, trailing only a streak of 10 straight starts from May 19-July 8, 2006.

**TIGERS PITCHER OF THE MONTH FOR MARCH/APRIL:** Liriano was named the Tigers Pitcher of the Month for March/April after posting a 3-1 record with a 3.38 ERA (29.1IP/11ER) and 21 strikeouts in five starts. He ranked 10th in the American League with a .196 (20x102) opponents batting average.

**PILING UP THE PUNCHOUTS:** Liriano has posted 27 games of 10-or-more strikeouts in his career. His last double-digit strikeout performance came on April 13, 2017 vs. Baltimore, when he punched out 10 batters. Liriano enters tonight's game with 1,694 strikeouts in his Major League career, which is the sixth most among Dominican-born pitchers. He is 26 strikeouts away from tying Ubaldo Jimenez for fifth.

**DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK:** Liriano has twice earned Comeback Player of the Year honors, receiving the honor in the American League with the Minnesota Twins in 2010 and in the National League with the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2013. He is the only player to win the award multiple times.

**TOSSING A NO-NO:** Liriano threw a no-hitter as a member of the Minnesota Twins on May 3, 2011 at Chicago (AL). He became the fifth pitcher born in the Dominican Republic to throw a no-hitter, joining Juan Marichal (1963), Ramon Martinez (1995), Jose Jimenez (1999) and Ubaldo Jimenez (2010).

**MISCELLANEOUS NOTES:** Liriano was signed by the Tigers as a free agent on February 23, 2018. He was originally signed by the San Francisco Giants as a non-drafted free agent on September 9, 2000. Liriano has played with six teams at the Major League level, including Minnesota (2005-12), Chicago (AL) (2012), Pittsburgh (2013-16), Toronto (2016-17), Houston (2017) and Detroit (2018).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Boyd turned in a quality start, but did not factor into the decision in his last start on Saturday at Toronto, allowing three runs on four hits with two walks and seven strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

**VS. TEXAS/AT COMERICA PARK:** Boyd has faced the Rangers five times in his career, posting a 1-4 record with a 5.53 ERA (27.2IP/17ER) and 18 strikeouts. He last faced Texas on May 21, 2017 and took the loss, giving up four runs on 12 hits with three strikeouts in 5.1 innings. Boyd has made 35 appearances, including 33 starts, in his career at Comerica Park, compiling a 10-9 record with a 4.00 ERA (189.0IP/84ER) and 142 strikeouts. In seven home starts this season, Boyd is 3-1 with a 2.61 ERA (41.1IP/12ER) and 32 strikeouts.
