WHEN IN THE COURSE OF HUMAN EVENTS...: Today, the Padres and Oakland A's celebrate Independence Day the best way they know how, by playing a day baseball game in the Bay Area...the Padres are 6-2 on July 4th since 2010.

- Last night, the Padres entered the sixth inning up 2-0, but left the decisive frame trailing 5-2, eventually losing the contest 6-2.
- Starter **Clayton Richard** extended his streak to 11 consecutive starts of throwing 6.0 innings-or-more, the longest streak of any left-handed pitcher this season...he was tagged with his second consecutive loss after earning the win in four straight outings, tossing 6.0 innings of five-run ball.
- **Travis Jankowski** (3-5, R) and **Cory Spangenberg** (2-3, BB) both collected multi-hit efforts for Padres last night.

RISPY BUSINESS: After going 2-for-9 (.222) with RISP last night, the Padres are 29-for-123 (.236) with RISP in their past 16 games since 6/15, the fourth-lowest average in the majors over that time...in the 16 games that preceded this stretch from 5/29-6/14, they were 33-for-104 (.317), an average that led MLB.

TODAY'S MOVES: Today, the Padres recalled RHP **Luis Perdomo** from El Paso (AAA) and optioned RHP **Colten Brewer** to El Paso.

LUIS IS BACK, TELL YOUR FRIENDS: **Luis Perdomo** is set to make his first start for the Padres since 4/18 after making 11 starts for El Paso, going 6-2 with a 3.10 ERA (24 ER, 69.2 IP)...he allowed two runs or less in seven of his 11 outings and tossed a complete game on three hits and one run on 5/4 at Albuquerque.

- Since the beginning of 2017, Perdomo has made 33 big league starts, with five of those coming against AL foes...he is 3-1 with a 3.21 ERA and 0.32 HR allowed per 9 IP against AL opponents...he is 6-12 with a 5.29 ERA and 1.02 HR/9 IP against NL foes.

SERIESLY?: The Padres are in danger of losing their sixth consecutive series since June 14-17 @ ATL (4-13) after the club won five-straight series from May 28-June 13 (11-5).

- The A's have taken all three games against the Padres this season...since 2015, SD has posted a 1-6 record against Oakland and has been out-scored by the A's 54 to 19...the Friars have 2.71 runs per game vs. OAK compared to the A's 7.71 rpg vs. SD.

ON THE ROAD, AGAIN: The Padres are on the road once again, having played 17 of their 27 June games on the road...by the end of the current trip (@ OAK and @ ARI), the Friars will have played 23 of their last 28 games since June 8 away from Petco Park.

WELCOME TO THE FAMILY: Reliever **Kirby Yates** and his wife Ashlee welcomed their baby boy, Kove Kali, into the world yesterday, weighing in at 9 pounds, 4 ounces and 21 inches long...as Kirby said, "Mom and baby are doing well, big sister Oaklee is excited to have a built in best friend."

WELL DESERVED: Prior to last night's game, Padres Bench Coach **Mark McGwire** was presented with his Oakland A's 50th Anniversary team jersey...he was voted on to the team by fans...The A's hosted a special pregame ceremony to honor members of the 50th Anniversary team on March 30.

PADRES ON DECK: On Tuesday night, LF **Josh Naylor**, 21, the Padres' No. 14-ranked prospect by MLB Pipeline, hit his 11th and 12th homers for San Antonio (AA)...Naylor was 2-for-5 to raise his batting average to .313.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#61 RHP LUIS PERDOMO (1-2, 8.36) [luisperdomo0061](#)

SOCK'S UP! 25-year-old **Luis Perdomo** takes the mound today for the second and final game of this quick two-game set against the Oakland Athletics.

INTERLEAGUE LUIS: Since the beginning of 2017, Perdomo has made 33 starts, with five of those coming against AL foes...he is 3-1 with a 3.21 ERA and 0.32 HR allowed per 9 IP against AL opponents...he is 6-12 with a 5.29 ERA and 1.02 HR/9 IP against NL foes.

WHILE YOU WERE AWAY: Perdomo made 11 starts triple-A El Paso from 4/23-6/27, going 6-2 with a 3.10 ERA (24 ER, 69.2 IP)...he allowed two runs or less in seven of his 11 outings and tossed a complete game on three hits and one run on 5/4 at Albuquerque.

LAST TIME OUT: His last start for the Padres came on 4/18 vs. LAD (3.0 IP, 10 H, 9 R, 7 ER), returning from a five game suspension for his participation in a fight at Coors Field on 4/11.

VERSUS THE CHAMPS: Earned the win in his first career start against the Astros on 4/6, holding the defending World Series champs to one run in his 5.0 innings of work in SD's 4-1 victory.

- Perdomo and the rest of the Padres pitching staff didn't surrender an extra-base hit to the Astros in the first two games of their series...it was the first time HOU was held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back contests since September 17-18, 2014 vs. CLE.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: Last season, Luis became the first pitchers to hit four triples in a season since PHI's Robin Roberts in 1955...only three pitchers had one triple in 2017, resulting in Perdomo having more triple in his 46 at-bats than all other MLB pitchers in their 4,534 at-bats.

THE GROUNDER GAMES: Last season, he led all NL pitchers with a 62.0 ground ball percentage, behind only TOR Marcus Stroman's 62.9 mark for the Major League lead...teammate **Clayton Richard** (60.0) and former teammate Jhoulys Chacin (49.2) ranked third and 14th, respectively.
