ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Last night, the Padres fell 4-0 to the Los Angeles Dodgers in Game 1 of the Mexico Series...it was the second occasion in Padres history in which a team combined to no-hit them (Sept. 11, 1991 vs. ATL), and it was the 10th time the Padres did not log a hit in a game...it was also the first combined no-hitter in MLB history thrown outside of the US or Canada... the Padres have a 3-6 record in games after being no-hit.

- Starter **Joey Lucchesi** worked 5.0 innings, tossing 99 pitches...he allowed three runs (earned) on five hits with five strikeouts and two home runs allowed.
- **Javy Guerra** made his Major League debut, becoming the first Padre in club history to debut internationally (discounting three Padre debuts in Canada).
- **Eric Hosmer** snapped a five-game multi-hit streak, one that tied for the longest of his career...in his past six games, he's now hit 11-for-25 (.440).

OH, MEXICO, IT SOUNDS SO SWEET WITH THE SUN SINKING LOW: Tonight, the Padres play Game 2 of a three-game series against the Dodgers in Monterrey, Mexico that represents the Padres third regular season visit to Monterrey... this series is the eighth in MLB history to take place outside the United States, Canada or Puerto Rico.

CINCO DE MITCHELL: Starter **Bryan Mitchell** has posted a 16.50 ERA (11 ER, 6.0 IP) in the first inning so far this season with a .433 (13-for-30) opponent average...after the first inning, he's owned a 3.42 ERA (9 ER, 23.2 IP) and a .238 (20-for-84) opponent average.

¡VAMOS VILLANUEVA! **Christian Villanueva**, native of Guadalajara, leads all ML rookies in home runs (nine), and in the event he homers in the Mexico series, he will become the first Mexican-born player to homer in Major League game played in Mexico.

GROUND(BALL) HOG DAY: The Padres have induced 393 grounders, the most of any club in the NL and tied for second-most in the majors.

FETCHING BAGS FRANCHY: OF **Franchy Cordero** has reached base safely in a career-high eight consecutive games and has six walks and a .412 OBP in that time...last night, he snapped his career-high six-game hitting streak...in his last seven games, he's hit .320 (8-for-25) in that time with a double and two homers.

GRAB SOME PINE: The SD bullpen has fanned 139 batters this season, tied for third-most of any relief team in the majors (LAD are fourth with 136 SO).

BACK ME UP: Padres hurlers have received 126 runs of support behind them, which ties for sixth-fewest support runs of any team this season...their 3.83 runs of support per nine innings is the fourth lowest mark in the ML.

¡FELICIDADES! Join the Padres in congratulating broadcaster **Pedro Gutiérrez** and his wife, Natalie, on the birth of their daughter, Natalia.

PADRES ON DECK: For El Paso (AAA), OF **Franmil Reyes** has now hit multiple homers in three consecutive games...Reyes was 3-for-4 with a walk and three RBI last night...SS **Fernando Tatis Jr.** went 2-for-5 on Friday with a double and a homer for San Antonio (AA)...Over his last four games, the he's gone 10-for-23 with four doubles, a triple and three homers for eight RBI... LHP **Logan Allen** allowed one run on four hits with six strikeouts over 7.0 innings for San Antonio...RHP **Luis Perdomo** allowed a run on three hits with six strikeouts in a complete-game victory for El Paso...in three starts this season in El Paso, Perdomo is 2-1 with a 3.13 ERA.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#50 RHP BRYAN MITCHELL (0-3, 6.07)

MITCHELL'S TURN: 27-year-old RHP **Bryan Mitchell** (who's 27th birthday was on April 19) is set to make his seventh start of the season and second of 2018 against the Dodgers.



LAST TIME OUT: Saddled with the loss in SD's 14-2 defeat, tossing 4.2 IP of four-run ball along with a career-high-tying five strikeouts (3x).

BACK ME UP The Padres are 1-5 in games which Mitchell has started, including two runs or less in five of his six starts and zero runs of support twice.

- His nine total runs of support (runs scored while he's in the game) are tied for the third-fewest among pitchers with at least 29.0 IP...his 2.73 run support average is the 12th lowest in the majors.

NO FREE PASSES: Mitchell has issued 23 walks compared to 14 strikeouts...his 6.98 BB/9.0 IP ratio is the highest in the majors.

GET THROUGH THE FIRST: Mitchell has posted a 16.50 ERA (11 ER, 6.0 IP) in the first inning so far this season with a .433 (13-for-30) opponent average...after the first inning, he's owned a 3.42 ERA (9 ER, 23.2 IP) and a .238 (20-for-84) opponent average.

KEPT IN CHECK: Mitchell and the rest of the Padres pitching staff didn't surrender an extra-base hit to the Astros in the first two games of their series on 4/6 & 4/7...it was the first time Houston was held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back contests since September 17-18, 2014 vs. CLE.

- Mitchell tossed 5.2-shutout innings on 4/7 at HOU, allowing just three hits but a career-high six walks in SD's 1-0 extra-inning defeat.

- Bounced back from a three-run first inning in his last outing on 4/30 at SF to toss four scoreless frames, including a career-high seven strikeouts.
- Allowed seven runs (six earned) across 3.0 IP in his Major League debut on a 37-degree evening at Coors Field on 4/24
- Became just the second pitcher of the entire 2016 draft class to make their ML debut, behind only teammate LHP **Joey Lucchesi**.

- This season with El Paso (AAA), he's started in 23 of the 25 games in which he's appeared, slashing .244/.296/.511 with three doubles, three triples, five home runs and 18 RBI.
- This Spring, Guerra played in 10 games and hit .294 (5-for-17).
