**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue on their first road trip of the season, a 5,200-mile, 10-day, 8-game odyssey, with the 2nd of 3 games vs. the Kansas City Royals (0-1)...opened the trip splitting a 2-game series with San Francisco (1-1) and played 2 of the 3 scheduled games vs. Minnesota (1-1)...after this series with the Royals will return to Seattle to begin a 7-day, 7-game homestand on Friday vs. the Oakland Athletics (3 G) and the Houston Astros (4 G)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...won 3 of first 4 games to start the season, but 1-3 over last 4 games...team is 3-3 during the day and 1-1 at night...Seattle is 2-1 at Safeco Field and 2-3 on the road.

- **AL Central** - the Mariners face an AL Central opponent in 12 of their first 24 games of the season (3-3)... Seattle went 18-16 vs. the Central in 2017, their first winning season since going 19-14 in 2014.
- **Seeing Double** - **Robinson Canó** is tied for 2nd with Rogers Hornsby for most home runs by a second baseman in Major League history, trailing only Jeff Kent's 377 career home runs.

**EIGHT IS GREAT**...**Dee Gordon** has hit safely in the first 8 games of the season, batting .353 (12x34) with 4 runs scored, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 2 walks and 3 stolen bases...his 8-game hitting streak is currently tied with Brian Dozier-MIN for the longest active streak in the American League...he is one of 10 Major League players this season to record a hitting streak of at least 8 games, trailing only season-long 9-game hitting streaks by Matt Chapman-OAK and Chris Owings-ARI.

**RIGHT WHERE HE LEFT OFF**...**Dee Gordon** has hit safely in the first 8 games of the season... dating back to Aug. 27, 2017, Gordon has hit safely in 37 of 41 games, including 21 multi-hit contests, batting .365 (65x178) with 30 runs scored, 3 doubles, 4 triples, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 4 walks and 17 stolen bases...during this stretch Dee ranks 2nd in the Majors with a .365 average (min. 75 PA), trailing only Josh Reddick-HOU (.373/38x102).

**DON'T YOU KNOW**...**Robinson Canó** has hit safely in 7 of 8 games this season, batting .407 (11x27) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 RBI and 4 walks...he currently leads the American League in average (.407), while also ranking T2nd in on-base percentage (.500), T9th in runs (8) and 9th in OPS (1.019).

**HE LIKES THE FOUNTAINS**...**Ichiro Suzuki** is a career .365 (95x260) hitter with 43 runs scored, 13 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 35 RBI in 63 games at Kauffman Stadium...among all players, Ichiro ranks 1st in batting average at this venue (min. 200 PA), ahead of Adrián Beltré (.355/66x186)...Ichiro has recorded at least one hit in 49 of 64 games here (37 multi-hit), including a string of hits in 41 of last 47 games dating back to 2005 (.407/79x194).

**KKKKKKKK**...**Edwin Díaz** has struck out 8 of the 11 batters he has faced this season (0 H, 2 HB), averaging 24.00 strikeouts per 9.0 innings over his first 3 appearances this season...in his career, Díaz has recorded a strikeout rate of 13.80 per 9.0 innings, the 5th-highest since making his debut in 2016...trails only Dellin Betances-NYY (15.32), Craig Kimbrel-BOS (15.24), Andrew Miller-CLE (14.43) and Kenley Jansen-LAD (13.85).

**MILESTONE TRACKER**...**Kyle Seager** is in his 8th season with Seattle, since making his debut in 2011 and is quickly moving up the Mariners all-time offensive rankings:

- **Seager** (214) trails Raúl Ibañez (216) by 2 doubles for 5th-most in franchise history.
- **Seager** (154) trails Raúl Ibañez (156) by 2 home runs for 6th-most in club history.
- **Seager** (529) trails Bret Boone (535) by 6 RBI for 8th-most in franchise history.
- **Seager** (363) trails Raúl Ibañez (367) by 4 walks for 8th-most in club history.

**LEFT IS RIGHT**...since 2012, **Kyle Seager** leads all active left-handed batters in home runs vs. left-handed pitchers with 53...during that span, he ranks ahead of Chris Davis (52), Jay Bruce (46), Anthony Rizzo (43), Joey Votto (40) and teammate **Robinson Canó** (39)...since 2012, **Nelson Cruz** leads all players in home runs off lefties with 60, ranking ahead of Giancarlo Stanton (59), Mark Trumbo (57), Josh Donaldson (55), Todd Frazier (55) and **Seager** (53).

**SOLVING SOUTHPAWS**...over the last 2 season, **Jean Segura** is batting .331 (42x127) with 6 doubles, 3 home runs, 11 RBI and 15 walks vs. left-handed pitchers...during this stretch, his .331 average this season vs. left-handed opponents is the 8th-highest in the American League...**Ichiro Suzuki** (.347/17x49, 3 2B, 5 RBI, 4 BB) and **Guillermo Heredia** (.311/41x132, 7 2B, 3 HR, 13 RBI, 8 BB) each have hit over .300 vs. lefties dating back to the beginning of 2017.

**PUT ME IN COACH**...INF **Taylor Motter** (1.0,1,1,1,1,1,HR,HB) made his Mariners pitching debut last night, marking his second career appearance on the mound (also: 7/1/16 vs. DET w/TB - 0.1,1,0,0,0)...Motter is the 8th Mariners position player to pitch in a game in club history (done 9x), joining Carlos Ruiz (6/13/17 at MIN - 1.0,2,1,1,2,1,HR), Mike Freeman (5/20/17 vs. CWS - 1.0,3,1,1,0,0), Luis Sardiñas (7/29/16 at CHI - 1.0,0,0,0,0,0), Jesus Sucre-2x (8/15/15 at BOS - 1.0,5,3,3,0,0,HR & 6/12/15 at HOU - 1.0,1,0,0,0,0), Jamie Burke (7/7/08 vs. DET - 1.0,1,1,1,0,0), John Mabry (5/28/00 at TB) and Manny Castillo (6/26/83 vs. TOR).

**CRAZY EIGHT**...due to 3 off days and 1 postponed game (inclement weather) the Mariners have played only 8 games in the first 12 days since the start of the season on March 29...the 8 games are tied with Kansas City and Minnesota for the fewest games played in the Majors, while Texas has appeared in 12 games.

**UNEXPECTED DAY OFF**...Sunday's game between the Mariners and the Minnesota Twins was postponed due to impending inclement weather...the game will be made up on Monday, May 14, beginning at 6:10 pm (CT)/4:10 pm (PT)...May 14th was a mutual off day for the Mariners and Twins...this is Seattle's first postponement since being rained out in Kansas City on August 5, 2017.

**AS MAY YOU KNOW**...dating back to Sept. 26, 2017, **Dee Gordon** has hit safely in 14 consecutive games, batting .367 (22x60) with 11 runs scored, 1 double, 1 triple, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 2 walks and 7 stolen bases...**BUT, DID YOU KNOW?**...Dee's 14-game hitting streak combined over the last 2 seasons is the 2nd-longest in his career?...his active 14-game streak trails only a career-high 17-game hitting streak, Aug. 27-Sept. 14, 2017.

**ABOUT FÉLIX...**

- 31-year-old right-hander is making his 378th career start and his 15th career start vs. Kansas City tonight.
- Is the only **active** pitcher in MLB who holds his **current** club's all-time record for career wins and career strikeouts (see more in "He's Our Leader").
- Is the second pitcher in franchise history to record 300 games started as a Mariner (also: Jamie Moyer, 323 GS w/Seattle 1996-2006).
- Signed a 7-year deal through the 2019 season on Feb. 13, 2013.
- In 2010 won the **AL Cy Young**, garnering 21 of 28 first-place votes... joined Randy Johnson (1995) as only Mariners pitchers to win the Cy Young...named *Sporting News* AL Pitcher of the Year...was 2nd in Cy Young voting in 2014.
- ML debut Aug. 4, 2005 at Detroit...Safeco debut vs. MIN Aug. 9, 2005.
- At 19 years, 118 days old at debut, was the 3rd-youngest player to debut in Mariners history & 2nd-youngest pitcher...youngest pitcher since Jose Rijo worked as reliever in '84 (19 years, 54 days (7/6/84 at MIN)).
- Born in Valencia, VZ...signed as 16-year-old non-drafted FA 7/4/02.
- A.L. All-Star: 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 (starter) & 2015, most by any Mariner pitcher and 4th most overall behind Ken Griffey Jr. (10), Ichiro Suzuki (10) and Edgar Martinez (7).
- Threw the first Perfect Game in Mariners history, and 23rd in ML history, Aug. 15, 2012 in a 1-0 victory over Tampa Bay at Safeco Field (9.0,0,0,0,12)...7th PG in MLB history to be decided in a 1-0 game, and 1st in the AL since 1984.
- Is 31-17 with a 2.65 ERA (127 ER, 431.1 IP) in 65 career GS in March/April.

**LAST OUTING...**

...took his first loss of the season, allowing 8 runs on 6 hits and 5 walks while striking out 1 batter in 4.0 innings pitched at San Francisco on April 4...allowed 3 runs in the 1st inning, but retired 9 of the next 12 batters he faced, allowing just 1 run on a solo shot by Gorkys Hernández...gave up a solo home run to Brandon Crawford and a three-run home run to Pablo Sandoval with no outs in the 5th inning before exiting the game.

**HOT STARTER...**

...in 65 career starts in March/April, Félix has recorded a 2.65 ERA (127 ER, 431.1 IP), the lowest among active pitchers and the 13th-lowest ERA in March/April in ML history...owns the 2nd-most March/April wins among active pitchers, with 31, trailing only Bartolo Colon (40).

**TOUGH ON THE CENTRAL...**

...in 84 career starts against AL Central opponents, Félix is 36-28 with a 2.93 ERA (181 ER, 556.1 IP) with 518 strikeouts and 153 walks...his 2.93 ERA ranks 4th-best since 1994 among pitchers with at least 300.0 innings pitched vs. the AL Central, including 2nd-best by an active pitcher...trails Mariano Rivera (1.70/66 ER, 348.2 IP), Pedro Martinez (2.09/83 ER, 358.0 IP) and David Price (2.61/116 ER, 400.0 IP).

**FOR OPENERS...**

...tossed 5.1 shutout innings in the Mariners' 2-1 Opening Day win vs. CLE on March 29, allowing just 2 hits and 2 walks while striking out 4... improved to 7-2 with a 1.52 ERA (13 ER, 76.2 IP) with 78 strikeouts in 11 career Opening Day starts...marked Hernández's 6th career Opening Day start allowing 1 or fewer runs, tied for 2nd-most all-time (also: Juan Marichal and Tom Seaver); trails only Walter Johnson (8)...lowered his career Opening Day ERA to 1.52 (13 ER, 76.2 IP), 2nd-lowest all-time among pitchers with at least 70.0 innings pitched on Opening Day (Walter Johnson, 1.31/18 ER, 124.0 IP)...now ranks 4th all-time in the Majors with 78 strikeouts on Opening Day (most: Randy Johnson, 107)...became the 7th pitcher in Major League history to record 10 consecutive Opening Day starts, the longest active streak in the Majors...is one of 14 pitchers in Major League history to make 11 Opening Day starts (most: Tom Seaver, 16).

**SPRING TRAINING RECAP...**

...in 2 Cactus League starts, compiled a record of 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (2 ER, 5.0 IP) with 5 strikeouts and 1 walk...Félix exited his first spring start after 1.1 innings on 2/26 at CHC after being hit by a line drive on right forearm (1.1,1,1,0,2)...allowed 1 R over 3.0 innings in MiL game on 3/19 at SD-AAA (3.0,3,1,1,0,5)...threw 3.2 innings on 3/24 vs. CHC, allowing a leadoff home run before retiring 10 of the last 14 batters he faced (3.2,4,1,1,1,3).

**2017 SEASON RECAP...**

...went 6-5 with a 4.36 ERA (42 ER, 86.2 IP) with 78 strikeouts and 26 walks in 16 starts...placed on the 10-day DL on April 26 with right shoulder inflammation...activated on June 23 after making three rehab starts (6/6, 6/11, 6/17 w/AAA Tacoma)...spent a second stint on the 10-day DL on Aug. 5 (retro to Aug. 2) with right shoulder bursitis...activated on Sept. 14.

**IMPRESSIVE START...**

...since 2005, has recorded 55 starts where he has thrown at least 6.0 innings and not allowed a run...that total ranks 2nd among starting pitchers behind only Clayton Kershaw (63)... the next closest AL pitcher (all starts in AL) is Verlander with 47...during this stretch Félix has recorded 247 quality starts, the 2nd-most in the Major Leagues, behind only Verlander (254).

**HE'S OUR LEADER...**

...became the Mariners all-time career leader in strikeouts on April 23, 2016 at the Angels (previous: Randy Johnson, 2,162)...became the club's all-time career leader in wins on May 9, 2016 vs. the Rays (previous: Jamie Moyer, 145)...is the only **active** pitcher in MLB who holds his **current** club's all-time record for career wins and strikeouts...Chicago-AL's James Shields holds both records for Tampa Bay, while Arizona's Jorge De La Rosa owns both records for Colorado.

**CAREER...**

...has spent entire pro career with Seattle...6-time All-Star (2009, 2011-15), 2-time ERA champ (2010, 2014), 2010 AL Cy Young Award winner...is 161-115 with a 3.22 ERA (898 ER, 2511.2 IP) in 377 career starts with 25 CG, 11 ShO, and 1 perfect game...holds Mariners all-time career records for wins (161), starts (377), quality starts (247), innings pitched (2511.2) and strikeouts (2,347).
