**NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES**

- The Yankees dropped to 1-2 on their seven-game homestand...are still 9-3 in their last 12G...are 7.5G behind Boston in the AL East.
- Have lost three of their last four home series after going 13-0-4 in their previous 17 home series...are 8-7 at home in August.
- Lost their first home series to the White Sox since going 1-2 in from 8/8-10/05 (were 10-0-2 in their previous 12 home series from 2006-17).
- LHP CC Sabathia** (6.0IP, 5H, 3ER, 2BB, 6K) started and took the loss...snapped his six-start unbeaten streak...was his first loss since 7/9-G1 at Baltimore...had 1-2-3 innings in the first, third and sixth...did not allow a HR for the fourth straight start...has 33K in 23.2IP over his last four starts.
  - Snapped his streak of five consecutive starts with 2R-or-fewer...has three consecutive quality starts for the second time this season (4/29-5/4).
- Yankees batters** were held to 1R for the fifth time this month after scoring multiple runs in all 25G in July...hit .183 (17-for-93) with 10BB in the series, with tonight's run the only one of the eight that did not score on a home run.
- SS Gleyber Torres** (2-for-4) had his sixth multi-hit effort in his last 11G, and is batting .385 (15-for-39) with 7R, 2HR, 5RBI, 8BB and 2SSB in that span...reached safely multiple times in all 3G of the series.
- 1B Greg Bird** (1-for-3) hit a third-inning double to snap an 0-for-21 drought.
- 2B Ronald Torreyes** (1-for-3) drove in the Yankees' lone run with a bases-loaded single in the fifth.
- In his third rehab game at Triple-A Scranton/WB vs. Syracuse, **C Gary Sánchez** (right groin strain) started at catcher and went 0-for-4.

**CHICAGO WHITE SOX NOTES**

- The White Sox finished their seven-game road trip with a 5-2 mark...are now 11-4 in their last 15 games (since 8/14) and 11-3 in their last 14 road games (since 8/3)...improved to 45-27 when scoring 4R-or-more this season.
  - Earned their first series win at the current Yankee Stadium and their first in the Bronx since winning 2-of-3 from 8/8-10/2005...finished the season series 2-4 vs. the Yankees...improved to 14-32 in the Bronx since 2005 and are now 10-23 at the current Yankee Stadium.
- White Sox starters** did not allow more than 2R in each of the three games during the series...carried a 2.29 ERA (19.2IP, 5ER) for the series...the White Sox improved to 42-33 when their starter goes at least 6.0IP this season.
- RHP Reynaldo López** (7.0IP, 5H, 1ER, 2BB, 6K) snapped a nine-start winless streak, earning his first win since 7/1 at Texas...has allowed just 2R in back-to-back starts.
  - Went 7.0IP in both starts vs. the Yankees this season...is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (14.0IP, 9H, 2ER, 4BB, 12K, 1HR, 1HP) in those two starts.
- 3B Yolmer Sánchez** (0-for-1, 2BB, 1K) has reached base safely in a career-high 17 consecutive games (since 8/11)...is batting .286/.416/.397 (18-for-63) with 11R, 4 doubles, 1HR, 3RBI and 12BB over the span.
- LF Ryan LaMarre** (3-for-4, 1R, 2 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI) recorded three extra-base hits tonight...drove in two runs with his two-out double in the second, one run with his double in the fourth and homered in the seventh...recorded his first extra-base hits since 8/14 at Detroit (HR)...was his first career multi-RBI game and second career HR...tied a career high with 3H (third time, last on 6/3/18 vs. Cleveland w/ Minnesota)...was his second career game recording multiple extra-base hits (also 6/3/18 vs. Cleveland w/ Minnesota, 2 doubles).
  - Is just the second White Sox batter this season with three-plus XBH and 4RBI-or-more in a game (also Matt Davidson (3HR/5RBI) on Opening Day at Kansas City).
- LHP Jace Fry** (1.0IP, 1H, 2K) earned his fourth save of the season...has not allowed an earned run in his last nine games (9.0IP)...opponents are hitting .182 (6-for-33) over the span.
