TRIBE HEADLINES

» The Indians own a 40-20 (.667) record vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, tied with Atlanta (42-21) for the 2nd-best intradivisional winning percentage in MLB (Boston - 45-19, .703)...the Tribe's 2.82 ERA vs. their own division is the lowest in MLB.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** (37HR, 29SB) is one stolen base away from becoming the third player in franchise history to log a 30-homer/30-steal season (**Joe Carter** - 1987, **Grady Sizemore** - 2008)...he ranks 2nd in MLB this season with 57 RBI at home.

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** currently leads MLB with 111 runs scored... he also leads all players with 17 home runs, 52 runs scored, 47 RBI (T1st) and 16 doubles (T1st) against the A.L. Central.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians brought the tying run to the plate in the 9th inning, but fell 6-4 in the rubber match of their three-game set vs. Tampa Bay...Minnesota's 18-4 loss at Texas yesterday dropped the Tribe's "magic number" to clinch the A.L. Central title to 13.

» **YANDY DÍAZ** had two of Cleveland's six hits, going 2-for-4 with an RBI-single that sparked the Tribe's three-run 9th inning...**MELKY CABRERA** (1-4) collected a two-run double in the 9th, while **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** plated the first Indians run with an RBI-single in the 7th inning...**ERIC HAASE** entered the game at catcher in the 8th inning and made his Major League debut, going 0-for-1 with a strikeout.

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** was handed his eighth loss of the season, allowing five runs on nine hits over 6.1 innings of work...fanned nine batters to tie New York-NL's **Jacob deGrom** for the Major League lead with 75 second-half strikeouts.

ROYAL WELCOME

» The Indians welcome the Royals to Progressive Field this week for the fifth of six series between the two clubs this season...the Tribe will conclude their 2018 regular season with four games at Kauffman Stadium from September 27-30.

» Cleveland has gone 8-4 overall thus far against the Royals, taking two of three contests in a pair of series at Progressive Field (April 6-8, May 11-13)...the Indians earned a three-game sweep in their first series at Kansas City (July 2-4) but were bested two games to one in their most recent matchup (August 24-26).

» In a rivalry that dates back to 1969, the Indians own an all-time record of 366-332 (.524) vs. the Royals, as well as a 63-44 (.589) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013.

DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE

» Cleveland has gone 40-20 vs. A.L. Central opponents this season, with a record of 13-4-2 in series play...the Indians' .667 intradivisional winning percentage ranks T2nd in MLB with Atlanta (42-21, .667 vs. N.L. East) behind Boston (45-19, .703 vs. A.L. East).

» The Tribe has gone 23-6 in divisional home games and 17-14 on the road...since June 17, Cleveland has won 12 of its last 14 divisional home games.

» In 59 games vs. the A.L. Central, Tribe pitchers own a 2.82 ERA (168ER/537.0IP), marking the lowest intradivisional ERA in MLB...seven of the Tribe's 14 shutouts this season (T2nd in MLB) have come against the A.L. Central, and the Indians have allowed three-or-fewer runs in 39 intradivisional games (33-6 in those contests).

SPORTSTIME OHIO HONORED

» Prior to this afternoon's contest, the Tribe's flagship television channel *SportsTime Ohio* will be honored in a pregame ceremony.

» *SportsTime Ohio* and *FOX Sports Ohio* were recently named the Regional Sports Networks of the Year at the Cynopsis Sports Media Awards...STO Senior Vice President **Francois McGillicuddy** will be presented the award by Indians owner **Paul Dolan**.

» The Indians finished the 2017 season with the highest-rated viewership in Major League Baseball and enjoyed the three highest-rated Indians games in history.

REHAB UPDATE

» **JOSH DONALDSON** has been placed on the 10-day Disabled List (retroactive to September 1) with a left calf strain.

» Donaldson is beginning his third stint on the Disabled List this season...is scheduled to begin his Minor League rehab immediately, and is set to play third base for Triple-A Columbus this afternoon.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

2000: Kenny Lofton has a memorable performance, going 4-for-7 with four runs scored, five stolen bases and a walk-off solo homer in Cleveland's 12-11, 13-inning victory vs. Baltimore...Lofton's five steals matched **Alex Cole's** (8/11/1990 vs. KC) single-game franchise record, while he also scored at least one run for an 18th consecutive game, tying the Major League record set by NYY's **Red Rolfe** (1939).
