MANAGER: **Craig Counsell** is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (241-256) and third full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (4th season), pitching coach **Derek Johnson** (3rd season), coach **Jason Lane** (3rd season), bench coach **Pat Murphy** (3rd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero** (3rd season) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges, going 1-5....their last challenge (won) came on 5/4 vs. Pittsburgh as an out call at second base involving Francisco Cervelli was overturned....team was 17-27 in 44 replay challenges in 2017.

TODAY'S STARTER: #41 - RHP JUNIOR GUERRA (5gs, 2-2, 2.33)

GUERRA AT A GLANCE: Junior Guerra, 33, will be making his sixth start of the season....

Guerra last started last Friday vs. Pittsburgh in a 6-4 loss (5ip, 6h, 5r, 5er, 4bb, 4k, 2hr)....the team has gone 3-2 in his starts....he has made 1 quality start....opponents are batting .202 (19-for-94, 2hr)....he began the season at Triple-A Colorado Springs, where he won his only start on 4/5 at Omaha....Guerra was claimed off waivers from Chicago-AL on 10/7/15....bio is on p. 97 of the media guide.

YOU NEVER FORGET YOUR FIRST: When he was claimed off waivers from the White Sox on 10/7/15, Guerra became the first player acquired under GM David Stearns, who joined the team on 9/21/15.

LAST SEASON: Guerra, the Opening Day starter for the Brewers in 2017, went 1-4 with a 5.12 ERA in 21 games / 14 starts....the Brewers went 4-10 in his starts....he produced 4 quality starts....opponents batted .230 (61-for-265, 18hr)....he went 1-4 with a 5.20 ERA as a starter (64ip, 37er) and 0-0 with a 4.26 ERA in relief (6.1ip, 3er)....Guerra had a pair of stints on the disabled list last season, coming from 4/4-5/25 (right calf strain) and 7/9-7/17 (right shin contusion).

CAREER: Is 12-9 with a 3.55 ERA in 49 games / 39 starts (223ip, 88er)....has pitched for Chicago-AL (2015) and Milwaukee (2016-current).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 6-4 with a 2.83 ERA in 25 games / 19 starts (114.1ip, 36er)....went 0-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 13 games / 7 starts last season (38ip, 16er)....is 1-1 with a 2.87 ERA in 3 starts this season (15.2ip, 5er)....**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 6-5 with a 4.31 ERA in 24 games / 20 starts (108.2ip, 52er)....went 1-3 with a 6.68 ERA in 8 games / 7 starts last season (32.1ip, 24er)....is 1-1 with a 1.59 ERA in 2 starts this season (11.1ip, 2er).

RHP Jhoulys Chacin will be making his ninth start of the season....Chacin last started last Saturday vs. Pittsburgh and received no decision in the Brewers' 5-3 victory (Gip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 4k).....the team has gone 6-2 in his starts, including 4 straight wins.....he has made 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .261 (40-for-153, 4hr).....he is 1-1 with a 3.31 ERA in 3 career starts vs. Colorado, all coming last season (16.1ip, 6er)....Chacin pitched for the Rockies from 2009-14.....he is 23-23 with a 4.23 ERA in 69 career games / 62 starts at Coors Field, including a no-decision in his only start there against the Rockies last 9/17 with San Diego (4.1ip, 5h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 4k)....Padres won, 4-3.
