CARDINALS NOTES (Extra Innings: 0-1)

- Miles Mikolas made his second start of the season, both against the Brewers (1-0) and has three total appearances (one in relief for San Diego in 2012)...surpassed 100.0 career MLB innings after he completed the 3rd inning.
- Marcell Ozuna has hit safely in eight straight games (14-35, .400) with a double in the 2nd inning...has hit safely in his last six straight games vs. MIL...was his second go-ahead RBI of the season, coming in the 3rd inning.
- Dexter Fowler has tallied an RBI in three different games this season, all against the Brewers (4 RBI total)...tallied a season-high two RBI...posted his second multi-hit game...committed his first error of the season, had one error all of 2017...hit his first sac fly of the season (21st career).
- Paul DeJong snapped an 0-for-12 with a double in the 4th inning...has hit safely in all four games vs. the Brewers this season (8-15, .533) with three multi-hit games of his four this season.
- Kolten Wong recorded the Cardinals first bunt hit of the season with a single in the 9th inning.
- Matt Carpenter has reached base safely in 10 straight games to begin the season.
- Jose Martinez left the game in the 9th inning with a right achilles contusion.*
- Yadier Molina has hit safely in five straight games (6-18, .333) and 9-of-10 games this season.
- Greg Holland set a career-high with four walks...had walked three batters six previous instances...Jerome Williams was the last Cardinals pitcher to walk four batters in an inning (9/3/16 at CIN, 8th inning)...the last pitcher in MLB to walk four batters in extra innings was Junichi Tazawa at NYM (8/28/15) with four walks in the 10th inning.
- Bud Norris has stranded all nine inherited runners this season.
- Luke Gregerson pitched 1.0 inning in a rehab appearance in Palm Beach (A), struck out two.*
- Both of the Cardinals losses to the Brewers this season have occurred in the final at-bat.

BREWERS NOTES (Extra Innings: 2-0)

- Jhoulys Chacin made his third start of the season, second against the Cardinals in 2018 (0-1) and seventh career start (8th app.) vs. the Cardinals (0-6)...the last time a team won in which Chacin pitched vs. STL was 7/6/10 in his first career appearance against the Cardinals in which Colorado scored nine runs in the 9th inning of a 12-9 walk-off win at Coors Field.
- Travis Shaw has hit safely in his last six games vs. STL (9-19, .471) and has scored nine runs over that period.
- Domingo Santana recorded his first RBI since 3/30 at SD...has hit safely in his last seven games vs. STL (12-25, .480).

- Manny Pina has three RBI this season, all against the Cardinals...first multi-RBI game of the season.
- Eric Sogard was 1-for-14 on the season entering today and had three hits tonight...his first three-hit game since 6/22/17 vs. PIT and also had two doubles in that game.
- Josh Hader has struck out three or more batters in each of his four relief appearances this season... tied his season-high with four strikeouts...leads all N.L. relievers in strikeouts through his appearance tonight.
- Lorenzo Cain hit an infield single in the 9th inning and *left the game with an apparent lower body injury*.
- Matt Albers has won back-to-back appearances for the 3rd time in his career...leads the Brewers with two wins this season.
- The Brewers lead all MLB teams with five wins by relief pitchers this season...Brent Suter is the only Brewers starting pitcher to earn a win this season.
