**THE GIANTS:** Open a 10-game, 11-day homestand tonight against the Cardinals, Cubs and Athletics...the Giants are coming off a 3-3 road trip where they went 3-0 at Arizona and 0-3 at Colorado...the Giants scored three runs on 14 hits during the Colorado series, which were both tied for second-fewest in a three-game series in Coors Field history (2002 Pirates scored two runs on eight hits) (*Stats LLC*).

**TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to tonight's game the Giants made the following roster moves: **RHP Johnny Cueto** has returned from his rehab assignment and has been reinstated from the 60-day DL...**IF Kelby Tomlinson** has been optioned to triple-A.

**BETTER AT HOME:** The Giants are 26-14 (.650) at home this season...the 26 home wins are tied for their seventh-most through 40 home games since 1958 and are tied for their second most since 2000 (also 2001; 27 in 2009) (*Stats LLC*).

#### AGAINST THE CARDINALS:

The Giants and the Cardinals have played 100 games since 2002, and the series is split 50-50...at AT&T Park, the Giants lead the series 28-27 over the Cardinals since the park opened in 2000.

**HERE'S JOHNNY:** RHP Johnny Cueto starts tonight after missing the last 61 games with a right elbow sprain...prior to being placed on the disabled list, he was 3-0 with a 0.84 ERA (3er, 32.0ip), the fourth-lowest ERA through five starts in Giants history (since 1920).

**GIANTS PITCHING:** Despite posting a 5.18 ERA (19er, 33.0ip) over their last four games, Giants pitchers own a 2.98 ERA (96er, 289.2ip) since June 1, which ranks as the third-lowest ERA in the Majors during that stretch behind the New York Yankees (2.65 ERA) and Tampa Bay Rays (2.93 ERA).

#### CRAWFORD VS. NL CENTRAL: IF

**Brandon Crawford** is batting .517 (15-for-29) against the NL Central this season, which is the highest batting average against any single division in the Majors.

**AGAINST RIGHTIES:** The Giants are 15-4 in their last 19 games against right-handed starters...SF will be facing all right-handed starters in this series against St. Louis.

**LOAD 'EM UP:** The Giants are hitting .328 (22-for-67) with eight doubles, nine walks and 60 RBI with the bases loaded, which ranks as the highest average in the National League and second-highest figure in the Majors behind Cleveland (.397).

**LAST DAY TO VOTE:** Voting for the 2018 All-Star game ends today...entering today, **C Buster Posey** had 1,675,468 votes, 8,218 behind Cubs' catcher Willson Contreras, who leads with 1,683,686 votes. .

#### This Date in Giants History: July 5, 1987

In a seven-player swap, the Padres trade pitchers **Dave Dravecky** and **Craig Leferts** and outfielder **Kevin Mitchell** to the Giants for third baseman **Chris Brown** and pitchers **Keith Comstock**, **Mark Davis** and Mark Grant...in 1989, Mitchell won the MVP for the Giants, and Davis won the Cy Young Award for the Padres.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#47 RHP Johnny Cueto**

**5-11, 229, 32 years old (February 15, 1986)**

**3-0 Record, 0.84 ERA**

- The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the disabled list prior to tonight's game to make his sixth start of the season.
- Was placed on the DL on May 1 with right elbow inflammation...saw Dr. James Andrews on May 7 and was diagnosed with an elbow sprain..missed the Giants last 61 games.
- Made his first rehab start with triple-A Sacramento Saturday, June 23 and tossed 3.2-scoreless innings, allowing one hit with four strikeouts (threw 48 pitches, 33 strikes)...made his second rehab start with triple-A Sacramento last Friday and tossed 4.0-scoreless innings, allowing four hits and one walk with six strikeouts (69 pitches, 44 strikes).
- The Giants are 4-1 in his starts this year and 41-21 (.661) overall since he joined the team in 2016.
- Prior to landing on the DL, Cueto had allowed just three runs in 32.0 innings of work (0.84 ERA), covering his five starts.
- Also missed nine games from April 10-17 with a left ankle sprain, an injury he suffered while working out in the Giants' gym...missed just one start.
- Cueto is one of seven SF Giants pitchers to hold opponents to run or fewer in each of his first four starts of a season.
- Flirted with a perfect game in his win over the Dodgers on March 30 but Chris Taylor ended the run at history with a single in the 7th inning.
- Has made 23 career starts against St. Louis, going 7-8 with a 3.74 ERA (57er, 137.1ip).
- Is 3-2 with a 1.91 ERA (9er, 42.1ip) and a .181 opponents average over his last six starts against the Cardinals.
