On a Series Note

The Brewers are looking to win their seventh consecutive series following series victories vs. Cincinnati (2-1; 8/20-8/22), vs. Pittsburgh (2-1; 8/24-8/26), at Cincinnati (2-1; 8/28-8/30), at Washington (2-1; 8/31-9/2), vs. Chicago-NL (2-1; 9/3-9/5) and vs. San Francisco (3-0; 9/7-9/9).

Let's Touch Base

Christian Yelich has reached base safely in 27 straight games (since 8/11), which is the longest active streak in the National ...the streak matches his career high (27g from 8/11-9/10, 2014)....he is batting .304 (34-for-112) with 10 HR and 26 RBI during this stretch.....only Houston's Alex Bregman has a longer active streak (38 games).

Special K Josh Hader struck out all 6 batters he faced in his last appearance on Monday at Chicago-NL, setting a new single-season franchise record with 127 strikeouts by a reliever (previously held by Corey Knebel with 126 strikeouts last season)

Putting the "K" in Knebel

Corev Knebel has retired all 15 batters faced, including 10 strikeouts, in 5 games since being recalled on 9/2....he has struck out 8 of his last 11 batters faced.

Sweet Home Chicago

In 170 games, Ryan Braun is a career .318 hitter (204-for-641) with 118 runs, 35 HR and 124 RBI against the Cubs, including .328 (104-for-317) with 55 runs, 17 HR and 67 RBI in 81 games here at Wrigley Field.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 45-27 at home, going 14-6-3 in series play.....after a 2-6 start, the team is 43-21 over its last 64 home games.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 4/17-4/22 and a season-high 3-game home losing streak from 4/7-4/16.....the team went 46-38 at home last season, going 14-9-4 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 38-36 on the road, going 11-8-4 in series play.....had a season-high 5-game road winning streak from 4/30-5/11 and a season-high 6-game road losing streak from 7/11-7/15....the team went 40-38 on the road last season, going 13-11-2 in series play.

MANAGER: Craig Counsell is in his fourth season as manager of the Brewers (303-304) and third full season.....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing Ron Roenicke.....bio is on p. 44 of the media guide.

COACHES: Hitting coach Darnell Coles (4th season), pitching coach Derek Johnson (3rd season), coach Jason Lane (3rd season), bench coach Pat Murphy (3rd season), third base coach Ed Sedar (12th season, 8th as 3B coach), first base/infield coach Carlos Subero (3rd season) and bullpen coach Lee Tunnell (6th season) all returned from the 2017 staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 30 replay challenges, going 6-24.....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/11 at Chicago-NL as an out call at first base involving Ryan Braun was confirmed.....went 17-27 in 44 replay challenges last season.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #57 - RHP CHASE ANDERSON (28gs, 9-7, 3.95)

ANDERSON AT A GLANCE: Chase Anderson, 30, is making his 29th start of the season and fourth against the Cubs.....Anderson last started last Friday vs. San Francisco and received no decision in the Brewers' 4-2 win (5ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 1wp).....the team is 15-13 in his starts....he has made 11 quality starts....opponents are batting .226 (123-for-545, 29hr)....he was on the 10-day disabled list from 5/13-5/20 due to illness, retroactive to 5/10....Anderson, who made the first Opening Day start of his career, was acquired from Arizona, along with INF Aaron Hill, SS Isan Diaz and cash, in exchange for SS Jean Segura and RHP Tyler Wagner on 1/30/16.....he is signed through the 2019 season with club options for 2020 and 2021... bio is on p. 60 of the media guide.

FITTING TRIBUTE: Prior to home starts, Anderson wears his late father's socks, cowboy boots, belt buckle, jeans and pink polo shirt to the park....his father, Robert, died in 2012.

LAST SEASON: Anderson went 12-4 with a 2.74 ERA in 25 starts.....he set career highs for wins (12) and strikeouts (133)....the team went 14-11 in his starts....he made 13 quality starts....opponents batted .220 (113-for-514, 14hr)....he was named Brewers Pitcher of the Month for April (5gs, 2-0, 2.10era) and September/October (6gs, 4-1, 2.06era).....Anderson was on the 10-day disabled list from 6/29-8/19 with a left oblique strain....he ranked sixth in the NL in ERA (2.89) and eighth in WHIP (1.11) at the time of his placement on the DL.

CAREER: Is 45-35 with a 3.89 ERA in 132 games / 131 starts (710.1ip, 307er).....is in his fifth MLB season.....has pitched for Arizona (2014-15) and Milwaukee (2016-current).....Anderson has gone 30-22 with a 3.72 ERA in 84 games / 83 starts as a Brewer (443.1ip, 183er).

CAREER AT MILLER PARK: Is 17-9 with a 3.97 ERA in 41 starts (224.2ip, 99er).....is 5-3 with a 4.92 ERA in 15 starts this season (78.2ip, 43er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 19-19 with a 3.89 ERA in 67 games / 66 starts (351.1ip, 152er).....is 4-4 with a 2.89 ERA in 13 starts this season (71.2ip, 23er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Is 4-4 with a 2.91 ERA in 10 starts (55.2ip, 18er), including 1-2 with a 1.35 ERA in 3 starts this season (20ip, 3er).....has gone 2-2 with a 3.58 ERA in 6 career starts at Wrigley Field (27.2ip, 11er).

CAREER AT THE PLATE: Is a .095 (21-for-222) hitter....has not homered....has 2 walks and 115 strikeouts.....THIS SEASON: Is batting .093 (4-for-43) with 2 RBI....has not walked and has 22 strikeouts.....has 4 sacrifice bunts.
